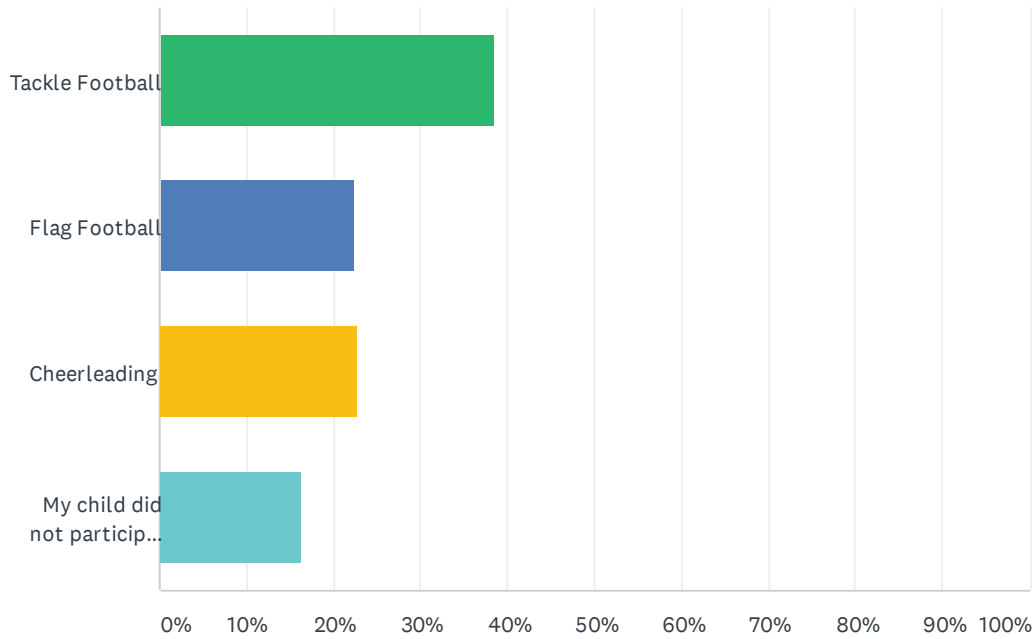


Q1 What sport did your child participate with during the Fall 2019 season?

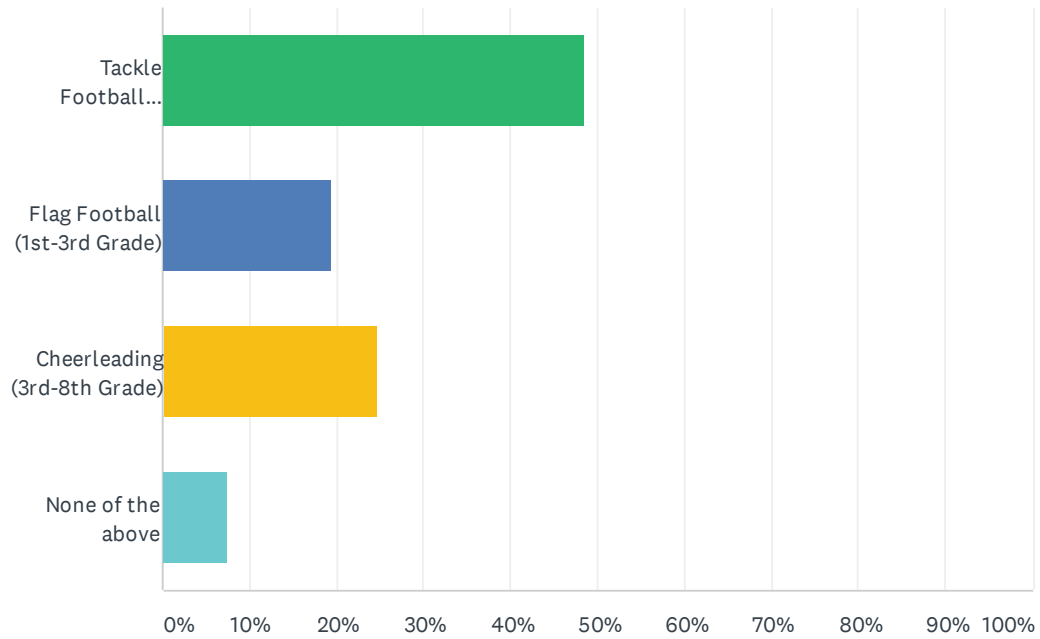

Q2 During the Fall 2020 season, what sport is your child eligible for?

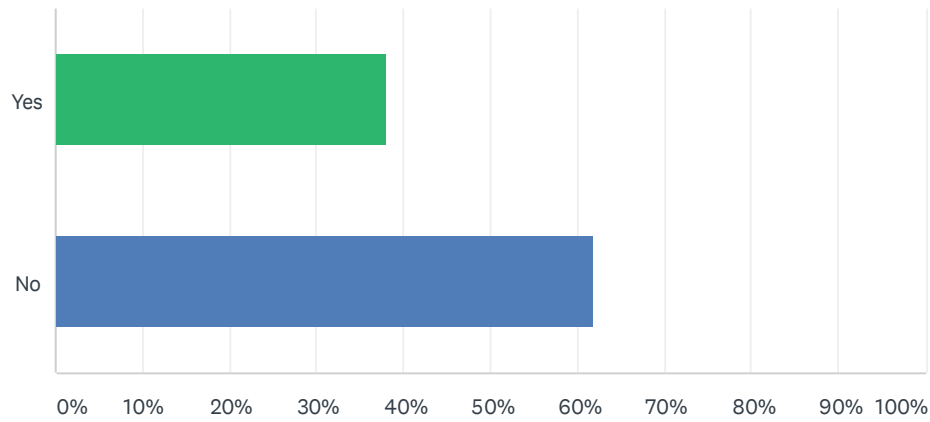

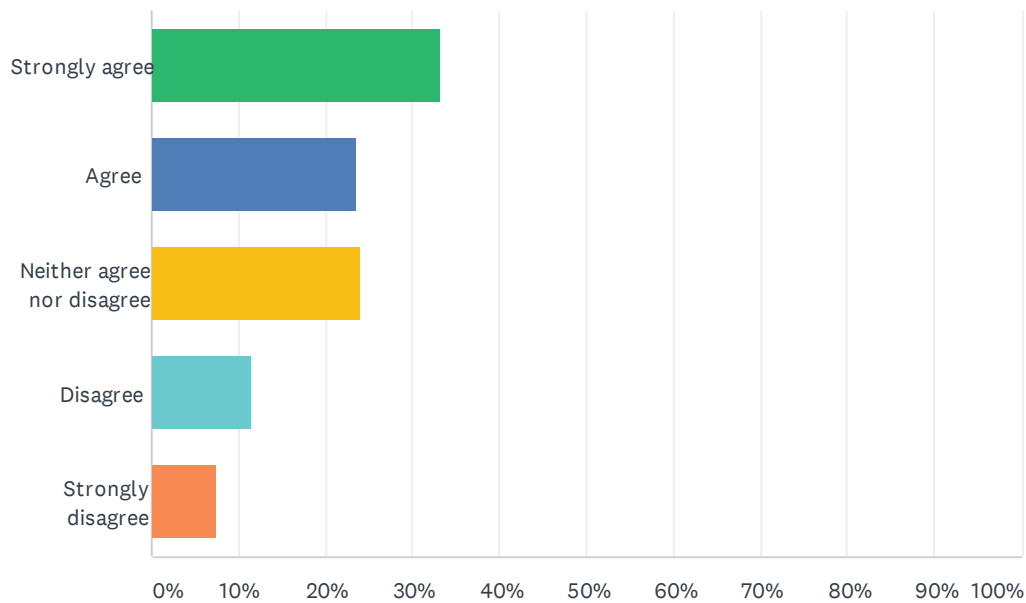
