Although preference is given to umpires returning from the previous season, the Umpire Directors reserves the right to exclude any individual based on their performance. There will be a series of classes held throughout March so as not to conflict with school sports. **The classes are required and your attendance will be recorded. Classes this year are on Sunday nights at the community room at the Police Station, Blackstone Street, Bellingham on March 1, March 8, March 15, March 22 and March 29. Class times are 5-7 PM. New umpires MUST attend all classes. Returning umpires must attend at least three, including the last class.** Failure to attend training classes may prevent you from umpiring this season. On the last day of the training sessions a 50-question exam will be administered, which ALL attendees must take. **A minimum score of 90 or above must be achieved in order to be an umpire, regardless if they umped the year before or not.**

First year umpires will be paid \$20 per game. Returning umpires will be paid \$25 per game. BYBI will provide one indicator, brush, bag, hat and shirt; additional to be at the expense of the umpire. Players must wear khaki pants and shirt provided by BYBI

I understand that I will be paid as a BYBI Official and that umpiring has several responsibilities to which I will be held. Failure to attend training classes or missing scheduled games may result in my termination from the program.
