



## U-15 Girls Team Tryout Information Sheet

Welcome to the Michigan Rush 2020 tryouts. We know not all of you trying out today will be placed on one of our teams but we do hope that everyone has a good experience at this year's tryouts. The costs below are based on fall and winter costs. If the team plays in the spring as well the costs will have to be adjusted.

The Michigan Rush was established for players who want more from the game of soccer. It is a program for those players that have better than average skill level and want the training and competition that will take their game to the next level. It is important that every player and parent understand that being a part of the Michigan Rush means more commitment than you may have experienced in other programs. We expect our players to practice at least twice a week, attend tournaments throughout the year and take part in all indoor training sessions.
