Boys Programs - Ages 4 to 18:

- **4 and 5-year-old boys play MUSHBALL:** (Coed) Basic skills taught, coach pitch, tee used if needed, emphasis on learning and having fun.
- **6 and 7-year-old boys play ROOKIE:** Basic skills taught, coach pitch, emphasis on learning and teamwork. RIF ball.
- **7, 8 and 9-year-old boys play MINOR:** Basic skills taught, coach/kid pitch emphasis on learning and teamwork.
- **8, 9, 10-year-old boys play JUNIOR VARSITY:** Players pitch and assigned according to draft and skill level.
- **10, 11 and 12-year-old boys play VARSITY:** Players assigned according to draft and skill level.
- **INTERMEDIATE DIVISION: 11-13-yr-olds:** 50ft mound 70ft bases, District League. Will need 30 players to offer. See page 4.
- **13 and 14-year-old boys play TRI-T PONY/LL Jr Lg.** Play in surrounding communities.
- **15 through 18-year-old boys play TRI-T COLT.** Play in surrounding communities.

- **8, 9 and 10-year-old girls play JUNIOR VARSITY:** Basic skills taught, players pitch and assigned by draft and skill level.
- **10, 11 and 12-year-old girls play VARSITY:** Players assigned by draft. Play in surrounding communities.
- **13 and 15-year-old girls play TRI-T PONY/LL Jr. Lg.:** Play in surrounding communities & the Fields of Dreams.

League Age Determination:

The BCB age is the age of your child as of **08/31/20** for **BOYS** and for **Girls 4&5 yrs old.** and **12/31/19** for **GIRLS 6-14yrs old.** Due to Little League rules BCB will strictly observe the age rules. All players must reside in the **BOARDMAN SCHOOL DISTRICT, ATTEND A SCHOOL IN BCB'S BOUNDARY MAP OR OBTAIN A LL WAIVER.**

Late and Final Registration:

Boys ages 11-14 and girls ages 11 thru 12, can still register and tryout until Friday, March 13, 2020. Boys ages 15-18 can register up to May 15, 2020. BCB Policies:

ALL 10, 11 AND 12-YEAR-OLD BOYS AND 10, 11 AND 12-YEAR-OLD GIRLS MUST REGISTER PRIOR TO TRYOUTS ON MARCH 7th or 13th, 2020.

Those who do not, will be on a waiting list to play in Boardman Community Baseball this season. ALL players in this age group must participate in tryouts. Those who elect **NOT** to participate in tryouts will be drafted to a Varsity or JV Division team. Those boys and girls who cannot attend the March 7th tryouts must contact their player agent to be excused and arrange to take part in a makeup tryout on Friday, March 13th. **PLEASE COME EQUIPPED WITH A GLOVE AND BAT TO TRYOUTS, IF POSSIBLE. BATS WILL BE AVAILABLE.**

Major Boys & Girls Draft:

BCB OPERATES UNDER ONE LITTLE LEAGUE CHARTER - BCB LITTLE LEAGUE. THE DRAFT SYSTEM FOR THE 2020 SEASON WILL BE A RE-DRAFT OF THE VARSITY/ JUNIOR VARSITY/ MINOR BOYS AND VARSITY/ JUNIOR VARSITY GIRLS DIVISIONS. THERE WILL BE 6-7 TEAMS IN ONE DIVISION FOR THE BOYS VARSITY AND 2-4 TEAMS FOR THE GIRLS VARSITY DIVISION. Girl's managers will observe ALL girls trying out. Boy's managers will observe ALL boys trying out. Following tryouts the managers will draft players to their respective team. All drafted players should receive a phone call from the manager within 48 hours of the draft date.

Boys 4 thru 12:

All 4 and 5-yr-old boys will be assigned directly to a Mushball team. Six and 7-year-old boys will be assigned directly to a Rookie Team. Coaches pitch at the Rookie and Minor level. Minor team's players pitch part of the season. Evaluations will be held for 7 thru 12-year-old boys to ensure that the talent level is evenly distributed amongst the teams in each division.

7-yr-old boys have the option of being evaluated and entering the Minor Division. ANY PARENT WHO WANTS THEIR SON TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A MINOR TEAM SHOULD TRYOUT WITH THE 8 YR OLDS (see below the time by age) . Any 7-yr-old that is not drafted to a Minor team will be assigned to a Rookie team.

All 8-yr old boys will be evaluated for the Minor Draft. 8-yr-old boys have the option of being evaluated and entering the Junior Varsity draft (see below the time by age). Any 8-yr-old that is not drafted to a Junior Varsity team will be drafted to a Minor team.

10-yr-old boys have the option of being evaluated and entering the Varsity draft (see below the time by age). Any 10-yr-old that is not drafted to a Varsity team will enter the Junior Varsity draft.

Any 11-yr-old player not drafted to a Varsity team will enter the Junior Varsity draft.

All 12-yr-old players will be drafted to a Varsity team unless parents make a specific request to play in the Junior Varsity Division.

Boys 13 thru 18:

PONY LEAGUE/LL JUNIOR LEAGUE (AGES 13-14 YRS OLDS):

This year in the PONY/LL JR. Leagues, players will be allowed to play in other Leagues (i.e. Class B 14U) while playing in the PONY/LL JR. Leagues. The COLT League will also allow play in other leagues.

Managers are not required to give these players any special consideration.

There will be at least 3-4 teams in the PONY/LL JR. Leagues, all participating in the Tri-T/LL & Jr. Leagues for 2020. There will be an A and a B Division with the number of teams in each division to be determined. The divisions will be based on players' ability. **TRYOUTS EVALUATING THROWING, HITTING AND RUNNING WILL OCCUR MARCH 13, 2020 STARTING AT 8:30 P.M. AT SLUGGERS INDOOR BASEBALL FACILITY ON SOUTH AVENUE EXTENSION FOR ALL REGISTERED PLAYERS NOT ALREADY ASSIGNED TO A TEAM.** Managers will pick their teams at the March draft. Each team will consist of 13-15 players. Non-drafted and Non-assigned players will go into a player pool for possible future participation. Pony/LL JR. season will begin in late April. Girls 5 thru 15 Fast-Pitch:

All 4, 5, 6, 7-year-old girls will be assigned directly to a Mushball or Rookie team, Coach pitch. **Most 8 and all 9 and 10-year-old girls play Junior Varsity League.** Player pitch. **Tryouts for 8's, 9's and 10-year-olds are being held to better evaluate a player's ability. This will allow us to evenly form teams during the JV draft. All 11 & 12-year-old girls who PLAYED on a LL Varsity Team in 2019 MUST participate in tryouts.** All who will play as a 7-year-old or younger this year, do not report for tryouts. **ONLY 8-YR-OLDS TRYING OUT FOR A JV TEAM SHOULD TRYOUT.**

Intermediate 50/70 Division:

In 2013 Little League International introduced the Intermediate 50/70 Division after a pilot program in 2012. BCB will participate in a District 2 League with other LL communities to be determined. BCB anticipates 1 team from our League. The age group is 11-13-yr-olds with 70-foot bases and 50 foot pitching distance. LL Junior Lg. rules will apply. There will be a separate draft for this League. Players can play both Majors/PONY/JR LL and Intermediate or Intermediate alone, but will be on two different rosters. The focus will be on learning additional aspects of the game (i.e. leadoffs, pickoffs etc.), increased competition and more reps for our players. Bats are LL approved bats. Pitching Rules are LL Pitch Count Rules. There will be additional BCB Pitching Rules incorporated within our league to assure pitchers are not overused. There will be District 2, State, Regional and World Series Tournaments. Players can only play on one All-Star Team. BCB will restrict 13's to the Intermediate team, 12's to the Major team and 11's to the 11 or 12-yr-old All-Star team. There will be a 12 game schedule. Fundraising:

In our continuing effort to raise funds to support our baseball programs and our complex, Boardman Community Baseball needs your help to make our fundraiser a success. Our goal is to raise \$25,000 dollars via our fundraiser. BCB is a private self-supporting operation that receives no financial support from the township, county, state or federal agencies. The main source of income to support our facility and operations is the hosting of tournaments and the annual fundraiser that we ask each player (up to two per family) to participate in. Again this year we have included the fundraiser in the registration fee. The cost of the fundraiser is \$50/player. New LL Residency Rule:

In 2014 Little League changed the residency boundary rule regarding where a player lives and the LL League they can play in. Each Little League organization has a boundary map by which their players must reside to play in said league. Now if a student attends a school that is within the league's boundary that player can play in said league regardless of their community residence. Proof of attendance is

required from the school's administration. Schools included within BCB's Boundary Map include Kirkmere Elementary, St. Charles, St. Christine and Valley Christian School. **A LL WAIVER MAY ALSO BE APPLIED FOR TO PLAY AT BCB.
