

Riverview LL 2019 A/Tball Bylaws

The Board of Directors of Riverview Little League has adopted these bylaws for the 2019 Season. These rules shall be followed without exception by ALL teams.

Pre-Season

1. Teams are encouraged to have at least 1 but no more than 2 practices/week prior to and during the season
2. Teams will be organized according to grade school and home address

Season

1. There will be 1 game per week and at least 1 practice per week (no more than 2 practices per week)
2. 1 hour time limit on games or 4 innings. No new inning shall start after 50 minutes
3. A Safe (soft) ball will be used
4. Bases will be 50 feet apart
5. Only the Head Coach and Assistant coach may be on the field during the game. One additional assistant may be in the dugout as long as he/she has had the proper background check
6. There will be no umpire; coaches will determine the outcome of every play
7. An unofficial score may be kept but league standings will not be maintained
8. Coach pitching is allowed, but a tee must be available at all times. A max of 4 pitches will be allowed after which a batter must use the tee. No extra pitches if a coach throws a bad pitch. We encourage coaches to pitch from a knee as it more closely replicates the pitching angles for youth
9. There will be no walks or hit-by-pitch
10. All teams are required to use a continuous batting line up. All players bat once per inning unless 3 outs are made
11. Runners may advance 1 base on an overthrow. If there is more than one overthrow during the play, the runner should not continue to advance.
12. For the purpose of teaching our young players the game of baseball, all fielders should be placed in regular positions. 9 players maximum on the field (there will be no player at the catcher position). All 4 outfielders must be in the grass and/or at least 10 feet behind infielders. All infield players must be in proper infield positions. ie. Pitcher, 1st base, 2nd base, shortstop and 3rd base. You may not place all your players in the infield.
13. No head first slides. The player is allowed to dive back to the base they came from
