

Canton Lions Football Head Coach Application

Being a Head Coach is an exciting way to be involved in sports but it isn't easy! Some coaches are overwhelmed by the responsibilities involving making daily practice plans, reviewing game film of opponents, attending monthly board meeting, keeping attendance records, holding their assistive coaches accountable for their actions, communication with parent, while at the same time, helping athlete through their early football experiences.

Experienced Head Coaches are not surprised, because they know coaching football requires more than bringing the footballs and any other equipment to the field and just allowing the kids to play. It involves preparing kids physically and mentally, teaching proper techniques, teamwork, to compete effectively, fairly, and safely in football and providing them a positive role model.

Many coaches are parents, but the two roles should not be confused. As a parent, you are responsible only to yourself and your child, as a coach, you are responsible to the organization, all the players on the TEAM (including your child), and the parents. A coach assumes the responsibility of doing everything possible to ensure that the players on their team will have an enjoyable and safe experience while they learn proper technique and football skills.

As a Canton Lions Head Coach some of the things that are required:

1. Report directly to the Unit Director.
2. To select assistant coaches as needed and submit same to the Unit Director for approval.
3. Head Coach shall be responsible for the actions of their assistant coaches and/or players while on the practice & playing field.
4. All Head Coaches shall conduct operations in complete compliance with all rules and regulations as established by the Lions Club Parent League and in accordance with the National Federation of State and High School Association.
5. All or any Head Coaches will be called upon to account for any violation(s) of these rules and regulations. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations could and will result in disciplinary action as recommended by the Unit Director with the approval of the Board and may include dismissal as Head Coach.
6. All Head Coaches are required to maintain an updated roster of all players in his squad and will report changes to the Unit Director immediately (within 24 hrs of said change).
7. Shall attend monthly Parent/Board Meetings and participant in all Canton Lions events.
