Updates Regarding the Spring 2021 Season

- **Registration is for Spring 2021 season will close 1/22:**
 - We know some families in our league have been affected financially by COVID-19. Our number one goal is to get every child that wants to play baseball registered. Below are some ways to assist families financially with the registration fee.
- **Early Bird Discount of \$25 has been extended everyone!**
 - Our board voted to extend the \$25 early bird discount until February 5th. The other discounts remain in place as well for military discount and multiple sibling discount.
- **T-Mobile Little League Call Up Grant Program available to help pay registration fees for families in need!**
 - T-Mobile donated 2 million dollars towards Little League registration fees. If you need help paying your child's registration fee, please click on this link [T-Mobile Call Up Grant](#) and apply for a grant. After you apply, they'll send an email to you to let you know if you're approved or not. They send the registration money directly to the league and we move your registration forward.
 - We've already had a few people request these grants and get approved. Please apply now, once the money is gone it's gone.
- **Peninsula Scholarships**
 - First apply for a T-Mobile grant, if not approved there or if that money runs out, you can apply for a Scholarship through our league. The scholarship form is on our website. Please reply to this email with the completed form to be considered for a full or partial scholarship.
- **50% Discount on Spring Registration:**
 - If you registered with our league in Spring 2020 and did NOT play free Fall Ball as an option, then you can reply to this email to request 50% off your Spring 2021 registration. You must complete your child's registration all the way up until payment before we can apply the discount. This is NOT an automatic discount. You must request it.
- **What happens if I register for Spring and we aren't cleared for games?**
 - The League is committed to providing an opportunity for our players to practice and participate in games. If games aren't allowed, we expect to continue to offer team practices and clinics in accordance with local guidelines.
- **Why is the League asking for registration if play status is currently unknown?**
 - We have received guidance from Little League to prepare for Spring 2021 Season. As part of that preparation the league is moving ahead with associated activities, including: paying for our charter and insurance, paying for permits, and buying equipment and uniforms. Registration fees will be used to fund these items. However, we are offering \$25 off our regular registration fee because we are asking families to commit to a season without knowing all the details yet.
- **Where did the registration fees go for 2020?**
 - 2020 registration fees were spent on charter, insurance, permits, equipment and uniforms to initiate our Spring Season. We incurred these costs before Opening Day of the 2020 Season. Our snack shack is our main fundraiser and we were only able to run it for a few days in 2020. We also offered free Fall Ball or 50% off Spring 2021 registration for those registered with our League in Spring 2020.
- **Why can't I wait to see if there will be games before I register?**
 - Preparation for Spring 2021 Season began in July 2020. In order to be ready to play we need to know the number of players and teams to plan for the Season. Managers, coaches, equipment and uniforms need to be planned months ahead of time.
- **What COVID-19 Safety Measures are in place?**
 - All our safety measures are posted on our league website at www.peninsulall.com , bottom right corner under Important Documents.

▪ **Volunteering and Background Checks**

- If you plan to volunteer this upcoming season, please register your child and select the appropriate volunteer role as part of the registration. Background checks will be emailed to you after January 1st. We need all managers identified before assessments.

▪ **Coaches Training and Umpire Training**

- Coaches training and umpire training will be held at the end of January – date and time TBD. You must be registered as a volunteer and have a completed background check to be invited to this training.

Please be patient and considerate. Remember that everyone that has been meeting, planning and running this league is a volunteer. No one gets paid for all the hours of work that are stuck into running this league. We all pay registration fees just like everyone else.
