Concussion Vital Signs (CVS) - Baseline Testing

At Home Instructions

CVS Baseline testing should be conducted in a quiet room. This test can be completed on a desktop, laptop, or tablet. Make sure to read the instructions thoroughly before starting each module. Baseline testing will take approximately 30-40 minutes. There is no need to print or send results as your certified athletic trainer will have access to these tests once completed. This baseline test will serve as a tool for your certified athletic trainer and/or team physician if your child/athlete sustains a head injury during a practice or game.
