- USAW Cards:** Every wrestler must either appear on an IKWF roster or bring in their USAW card to compete. Coaches must show USAW card with NCEP Copper or Bronze Certification and sign-in to receive wrist band.
- Entry Fee:** \$30.00 pre-registration only on TrackWrestling.com (search for fallon or pummel)
Registration Deadline is midnight February 12th **OR until registration hits the limit**
Strict limit of the first 650 entries.

- Weigh Ins:** **ALL Wrestlers must weigh-in FRIDAY evening.** Locations and times of all weigh-in facilities will be posted to the tournament on TrackWrestling.com. Team coach/administrators wanting to host a satellite weigh-in for your area need to contact TournamentDirector@LittlePanthers.com prior to February 6th.

- Format:**
- 16-Man, 8-Man, 6-Man, 4-Man and 2-Man brackets will be used.
 - Top 4 wrestlers will be seeded (Seeding criteria on the back of this flyer)
 - Tables equipped with TrackWrestling clocks.
 - No bullpen - Projectors will display the bout schedule with mat assignment.
 - Follow the tournament on trackwrestling.com
 - 4&5, 6&7 and 8&9 Divisions will wrestle on half mats (three 1 minute periods)
 - 10&11 and 12-14 Divisions will wrestle on full mats
Three 1.5 minute periods on the championship side & round robin brackets
Three 1 minute periods on the consolation side
- Awards:** Trophies for 1st – 4th
Team Trophy for the top TEN team scores (nice walnut team trophies).
- Admission Fee:** \$5 per person
- Food:** Concessions available all day. Water & snacks will be available to coaches only.
No coolers or outside food/beverages will be allowed in the school.

Metro-East Trinity Belt: The Panther Pummel is the final tournament in this series along with the Belleville Little Devils Open 12/21/2019 and Granite City Kids Holiday Classic 12/29/2019. Wrestlers who win all three tournaments will earn a Metro-East Trinity belt (Southern Illinois winners will be awarded at the IKWF South Sectional).

Seeding Criteria: Seeding will be based off of the wrestler's placement at the following four tournaments and ONLY these four tournaments:

- **2019 O'Fallon Panther Pummel**
- **2019 USAW State Championships for your state (no AAU, NuWay, Freestyle or Greco-Roman)**
(IL wrestlers can include 2019 Bantam or 2019 Midget Championships)
- **2019 Belleville Little Devils Open**
- **2019 Granite City Kids Holiday Classic**

It is the responsibility of whoever registers the wrestler to enter the placement for the 2019 USAW State.

The seeding points for the three MET tournaments will automatically be calculated and entered into TrackWrestling. The tournament director will break ties in seeding points using a coin flip.

If you register early, keep the e-mail confirmation from TrackWrestling which will have a link to go back into your registration later to edit state placement & weight classes up until registration closes.

Seeding Points per Tournament:

1 st	20 points
2 nd	15 points
3 rd	12 points
4 th	10 points
5 th	8 points
6 th	6 points
7 th	4 points
8 th	2 points
No Place/Participation	1 point

Example: 37 points – 2019 Panther Pummel (1st/20 points), 2019 USAW State (4th/10 points), 2019 Belleville Little Devils Open (6th/6 points) and 2019 Granite City Kids Holiday Classic (Part/1 point).

Make sure your wrestlers report to the score table after a win to ensure that the table workers have the correct winner listed. All incorrectly entered bouts must be reported to the head table immediately to be corrected. We will not change an error once the next round has wrestled.

This has become one of the toughest tournaments in the region with wrestlers coming from several different states to include AR, GA, IA, IL, IN, KY, MD, MO, MS, OH, OK, PA, TN, TX and VA. Last year we had over 630 kids register and over a third of those kids were from out of state. We expect to max out at 650 wrestlers again this year. Register early to avoid getting locked out.

Don't forget that we offer a team trophy to the top 10 team scores (nice walnut team trophies). The top 12 scorers from each team will automatically count towards the team's score. Team scores will be calculated at the end of the tournament.

You may change your weight class up until the time registration closes by using the link from the e-mail confirmation from TrackWrestling. After registration closes, there will be no weight class changes, however, those wrestlers who weigh-in heavy will be moved to the next higher weight class at no extra charge.

IKWF bylaws require IKWF sanctioned tournaments to verify both wrestlers and coaches USAW membership to participate. All Illinois wrestlers and coaches must appear on the IKWF website and out of state wrestlers must have their USAW cards available in case what is entered into TrackWrestling does not pass the automatic check. All coaches must sign-in with their USAW card with NCEP Copper or Bronze Certification to receive a wristband that will allow them on the mats.
