3. I understand that my initial deposit of \$150.00 is NON refundable. INT_____
4. Refunds will be money paid Minus the NON refundable of \$150.00. Refunds will be issued only if the participant withdraws prior to the FIRST DAY OF PRACTICE. (27 July 2020)
5. There are NO refunds AFTER THE FIRST DAY of PRACTICE, on any FUNDRAISING MONEY or BUYOUTS, on CHEERLEADER UNIFORMS. NO refund will be issued if all Los Toros Equipment has not be returned. Following the end of the conditioning period, request for refunds will only be considered for MEDICAL REASONS. INT_____
6. In order for the program to be successful, we must have shared participation by all parent/guardians of the children involved. To understand the effort required, we need over 30 parent volunteers for just one of our home game days. I agree to work my assigned shift for my child's team/division during the 2019 football season for Los Toros Youth Football and Cheer. INT_____
7. The equipment that is issued for the use of playing football is the sole property of Los Toros Youth Football and Cheer (LTYFC) and is on loan for the explicit use to play football for the LTYFC Association. Parents/Players are responsible for the care and return of the issued equipment by December 31 of the current calendar year. Failure to do so will result in a \$350.00 fine or prosecution. INT_____
8. I understand that if I provide my own equipment that it will have to be approved by a Los Toros Equipment Director. INT_____.

2020 REFUND POLICY

Deposits are non-refundable unless a written request to cancel registration is received or postmarked within 72-hours from the registration date.

A REGISTRATION FEE REFUND WILL BE PRORATED AS FOLLOWS:

A full refund, **Minus** the initial NON-Refundable deposit which covers the Administrative Fees*, will be issued only if the participant withdraws prior to the **FIRST DAY OF PRACTICE. (27 July 2020)**

- **NO REFUNDS:**
 - WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE FIRST DAY OF PRACTICE.
 - WILL BE GIVEN ON ANY FUNDRAISING MONEY OR BUYOUTS.
 - WILL BE GIVEN ON CHEERLEADER UNIFORMS.
 - WILL BE GIVEN UNLESS ALL ISSUED GEAR IS RETURNED.
- Following the end of the conditioning period, request for refunds will only be considered for MEDICAL REASONS. A letter written by your physician and/or a signed PHYSICAL STATEMENT must accompany the refund Request Letter
- There will be a \$35.00 NSF Fee assessed for any returned checks. If the amount of the returned check plus the NSF Fee is not paid to LTYFC within 5 days of notification, the participant will lose his/her eligibility within the Association and/or will be suspended from participation until total amount due is paid in cash or money order.

A signed written request for refund must be submitted for consideration. Refunds will be processed within 4 weeks of submission. Date of submission shall be determined as to the date received by the Treasurer.

- Document preparation, processing, handling, copying, securing and notification.
- Additional Rostering, Weigh-ins, Insurance and Assessment by San Diego Youth Football and Cheer.
- Purchase of football jersey, individually sized and personalized with player's name.
- Other additional Fees assessed by San Diego County Youth Football and Cheer Organization.
- Fundraising monies not collected.
- Academic Ineligibility.

PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT

All parents/guardians who have children participating within the Los Toros Youth Football and Cheer Association must abide by a code of conduct which includes the provisions that follow.

Any violation of these rules may result in the revocation of privileges in the Association.

- * I/we hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parent's Code of Conduct.
- * I/we will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, cheerleaders, coaches and Officials at every game, practice, or other youth sport event.
- * I/we will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desires to win.
- * I/we will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- * I/we will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Conduct.
- * I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- * I/we will demand a sports environment free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- * I/we will remember that game day is for youth - not ADULTS.
- * I/we will do my best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- * I/we will ask my child to treat other players, cheerleaders, coaches, fans, parents, and officials with respect regardless of race, creed, sex or ability.
- * I/we agree to furnish proof of Birth - i.e. Birth Certificate, Current Passport, or Military ID of the applicant to the Association/SDYFC upon request.
- * I/we agree to furnish a copy of the most recent school years Report Card to the Association/SDYFC upon request.
- * I/we agree that my child will participate in the "Little Scholars Program" set up by the SDYFC and National Youth Football.
- * I/we agree to be financially responsible for the Association/Youth Football equipment issued to the applicant other than normal wear and breakage during games and practice. Further, I/we will reimburse the Association/SDYFC for the loss and/or damage to said equipment.
- * I/we agree NOT to smoke on the practice or playing field, or in the presence of a gathering of a team/squad.
- * I/we agree to abstain from the possession and drinking of alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of any illegal substance at any Youth Football function.
- * I/we agree not to deliberately incite or participate in "unsportsmanlike" conduct at any Youth Football function.
 - I/we agree not to use abusive or profane language at any time at any Youth Football function.
- * I/we agree not to criticize, belittle, antagonize, berate or otherwise incite the opposing team, its players, coaches, cheerleaders or fans by word of mouth or gestures.
- * I/we agree to accept all decisions of the game officials, judges, or SDYFC officials as being fair and called to the best of their ability.
- * I/we agree to follow the proper chain of command when filing a complaint or voicing my opinion regarding any possible rule infraction or concern within the SDYFC.
 - A. Head Coach. B. Coaching/Cheer director. C. Vice President. D. Request a meeting with the Executive Board.
- * I/we agree not to interfere with or come near the "scale area" at the football field, where the weigh-in and pregame check-in is taking place with the SDYFC.
- * I/we agree to take responsibility for any actions that violates this code of conduct by a guest or relative of attending parents/guardians.
- * Any act of disrespect from a parent/fan directed towards game officials/judges, or Conference officials, creating a disturbance either in the stands or on the playing field, or has to be ejected from a game, practice or event, by the SDYFC official or game official, the penalty will be handed down to that individual immediately by the Association official, and the assessed penalty will not require a hearing to be assessed.

However, any penalty assessed to any individual may be appealed in writing to the SDYFC via the Home Association Board of Directors, within 72 hours from the time the penalty was assessed. The appeal will be handled in accordance with the San Diego Youth Conference Administration Manual and Association By-Laws.
