

Covid-19 Return to Play

WCYBL will not be able to offer a basketball league for Pre-K, Kindergarten, 1st grade, 2nd grade, or Premier League participants.

WCYBL will offer a league for eligible players in Division 1 (3rd & 4th grades), Division 2 (5th & 6th grades), Division 3 (7th and 8th grades) and Division 4 (High School). WCYBL will offer 3 sessions:

Session	Approximate Time Frame*	Division	Grades
1	November 16 - December 30	Div 3 and Div 4	7th, 8th, HS
2	January 2 - January 30	Div 2	5th, 6th
3	February 1 - February 28	Div 1	3rd, 4th

*Time Frames are Approximate and Subject to Change

- Each team will be scheduled 2 practices and 9 games. (**No post-season Tourn.**)

Restrictions due to COVID-19 include but are not limited to the following:

- Games will have a hard stop of one hour. (Ex: Game starts at 5:30 and if not over by 6:30, game will be stopped immediately)
- Participants or Spectators will not enter the gym until five minutes before scheduled event.
- Everyone must leave the gym as soon as the event is over.
- No bleachers will be provided. If players or spectators wish to bring a chair, it must have rubber or felt tips on the bottom of the legs.
- A maximum of 24 spectators will be allowed per team. If the max number of spectators is exceeded, the game will be stopped. If the number of spectators doesn't get under the limit within ten minutes, the game will be canceled and will not be rescheduled.
- All spectators must wear a mask while in the facility and socially distance.
- Players must wear a mask and socially distance while they are not playing. (i.e. before the game, while on the bench, and after the game). If a player fails to wear a mask or social distance, a warning will be given and if the player continues to not comply with the rules, a technical foul will be issued.
- WCYBL is required to follow KHSAA guidance for return to play. Please visit khsaa.org for additional information.

Registration – There will be limited player capacity in each session. When online registration opens, everyone who registers will be put on a waitlist. Registering on the waitlist does not guarantee a spot on a roster. After coaches are selected, the player pool will come from those who registered on the waitlist first. **YOU WILL NOT PAY WHEN YOU SIGN UP ON THE WAITLIST.** When a player is added to a roster, the registrant will receive an email to go to the website to pay the registration fee. The registrant will have two weeks to pay. If payment is not received within 2 weeks, the jersey will be withheld, and the player will not be able to participate.
