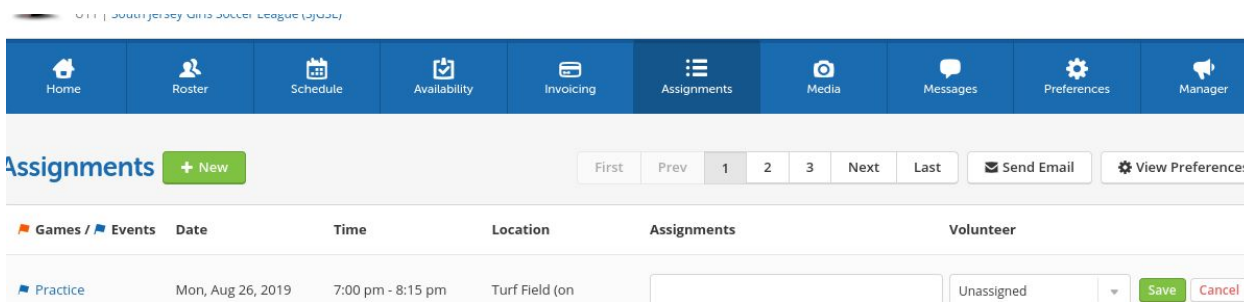

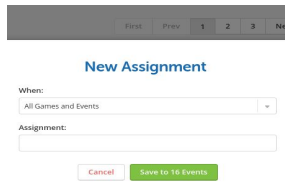
How to create “Assignments” to give to players:

Step 1- Before you “assign” event drills to your players you should go to the Website on a computer or tablet browser (not in the app) and create “assignments” By creating multiple assignments (see next step) they will show up on your App and then makes it very easy to assign to the players that are participating in the “event” challenge you created.

Step 2- Creating assignments

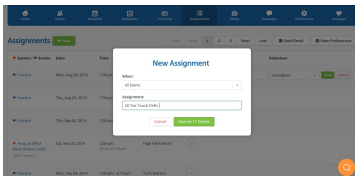


Click on the “assignment” tab on the website
Then click on “NEW” (green button) in this tab.



Click on drop down to add to “All Events”

The assignment (drill) can be whatever you feel would work for your team/level/age group.



Step 3- You created as many assignments as possible on the website for your team. NOW in the App you 1) Create an event 2) make event @home, make for 12 hours) etc. 3) Once an event is created, go to the event and add players from the line-up, then by player assign them an “assignment” to complete during the time period created (how long did you make the event?)
