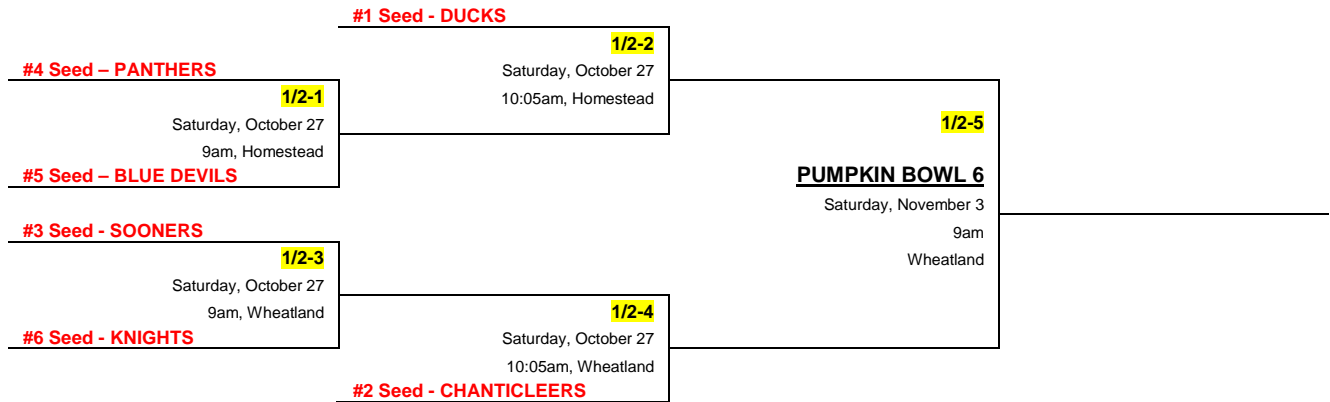

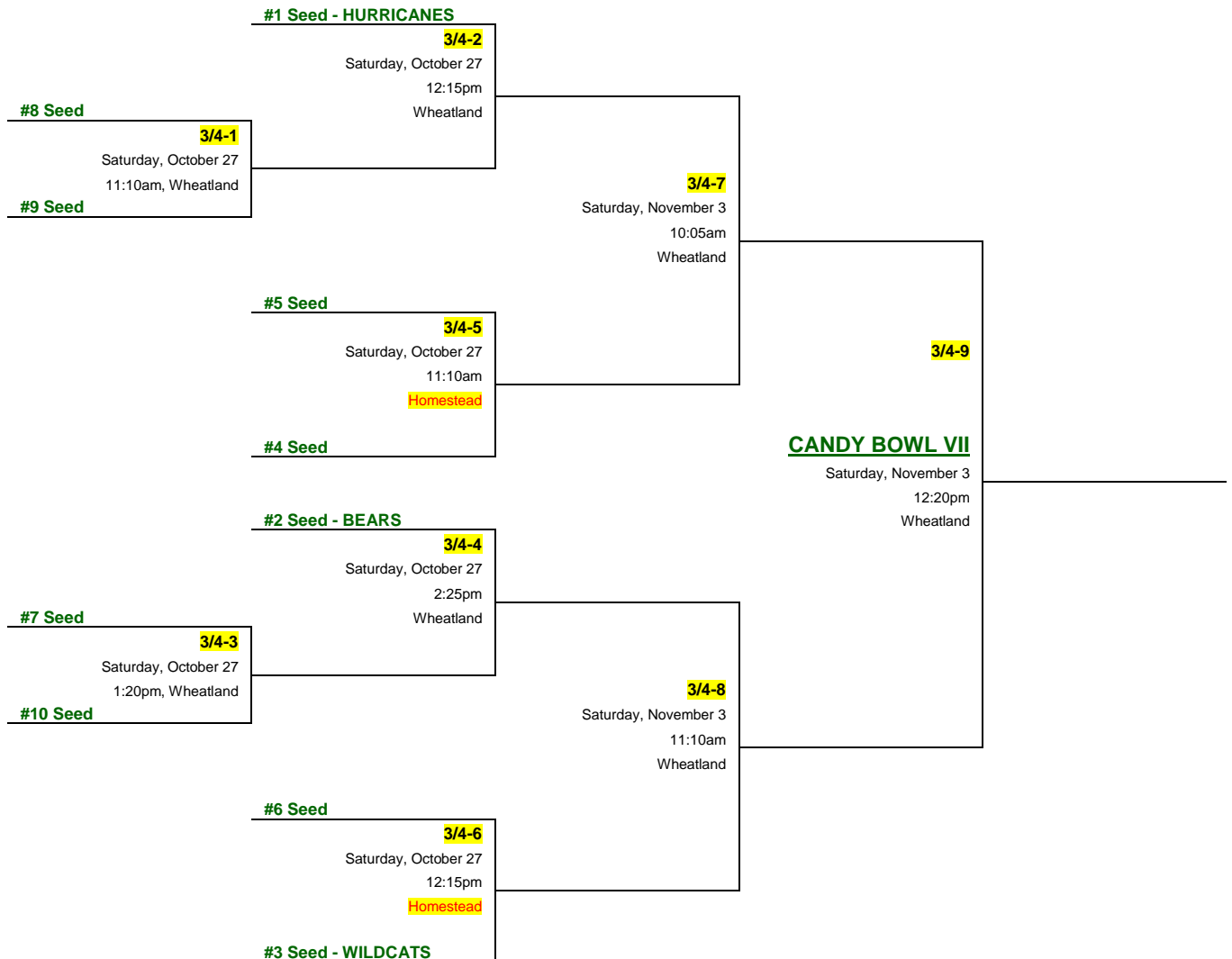

## 1<sup>st</sup> -2<sup>nd</sup> Grade PUMPKIN PLAYOFFS



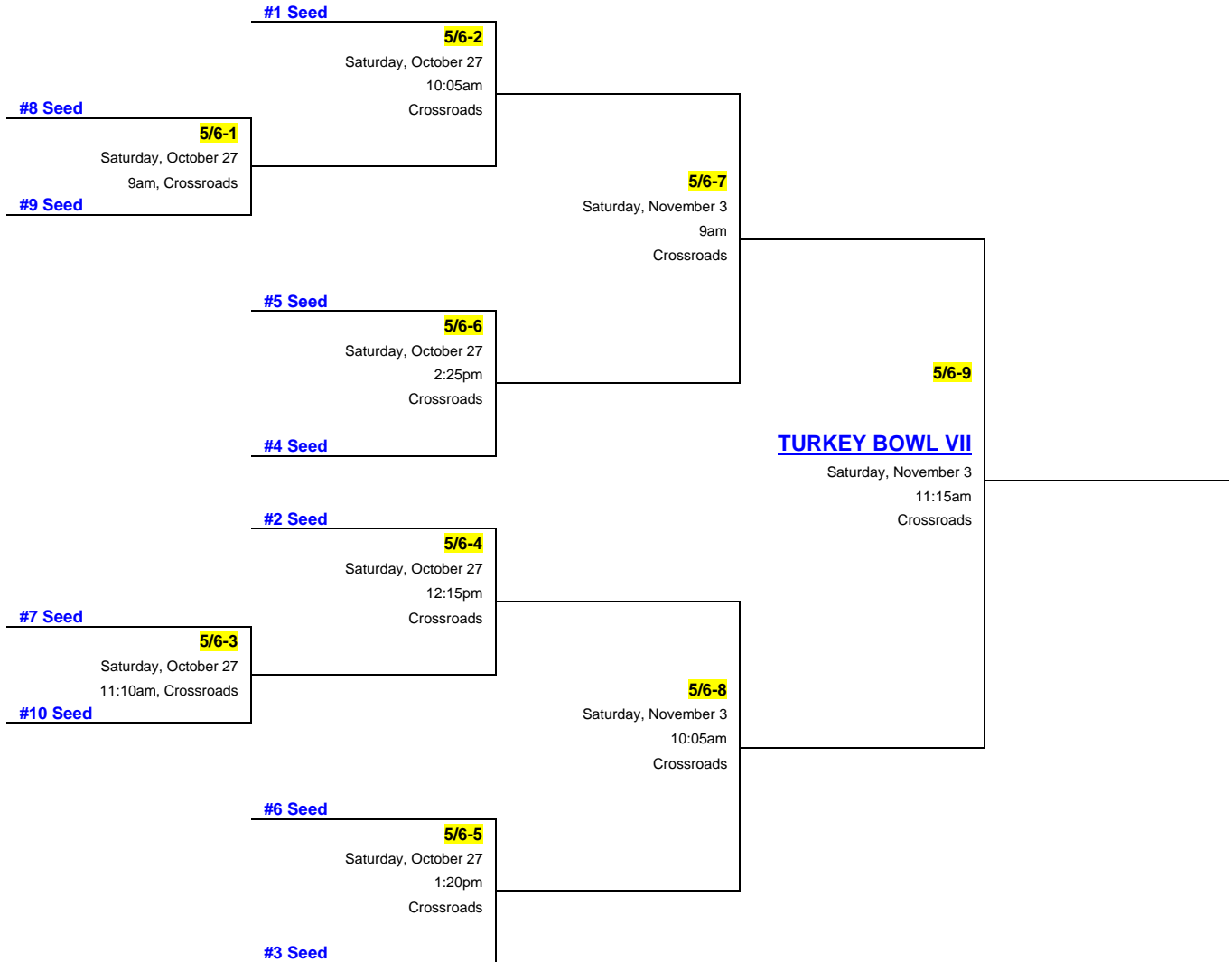
