

WEST COAST REGIONAL SHOWCASE

FIFA RULES

FIFA Rules as modified by US Club Soccer, and as further modified herein, will apply.

SPORTSMANSHIP

Good sportsmanship is expected of all players, coaches, managers, and fans.

HOME TEAM

The team listed first on the schedule is the home team. Home team will be responsible to provide 3 sanitized game balls. If there is a conflict in team colors, as determined by the referee, the home team shall switch to an alternate jersey or alternate uniform pieces.



CHECK IN

All teams are required to check in online prior to the event. Each player must have a signed COVID waiver, Pre Screen waiver, a medical release form and their current players pass. Due to COVID each player with their team is to report to the Medical tent for a temperature check each day (prior to warm-up) and the COVID symptoms check. Once the players are cleared they may report to their field. They are not to go to the players bench area until the field is clear. To minimize contact there will be no exchange of players passes or games cards. However each manager will be given a form signed by our staff to present at each game showing that they did all of the prior mandatory check in. By registering your team, you are committing to play all games scheduled for your team. If your team does not show for a game without an extraordinary excuse, your team will not be asked back to any of our events. Games not played will be classified as a forfeit. ALL teams are committed to playing games, as scheduled.

CREDENTIALS:

At the Mandatory Check In, Players will need to report to the Medical tent each day to get temperature check (prior to warm-ups) Managers must show the signed document stating they completed the online check-in and must turn in the players signed COVID waivers and pre-screening form to the tournament staff prior to playing. At all times they must have a valid Player I.D. Cards with photographs, and signed Medical Release Forms on hand.

ROSTERS: Up to twenty-six (26) players may register, twenty (20) players can dress per game.

GUEST PLAYERS:

Teams may use an unlimited amount of guest players as long as they are sanctioned under the same association as the rest of the team (USYSA or US Club), but are still subject to the maximum roster size rules above. Meaning – guest players must have the same type of player card as the team they are guest playing for. Players in tournament may play on more than one team within their club as long as they are in a different age group. Those players must be rostered and check in with both teams.

GAME CHECK-IN:

Referees will perform safety checks prior to the start of each game. Field marshals will maintain game reports. Team managers must bring all player cards to every game, but do not need to provide player cards to field marshal or referee unless asked to do so.

START TIMES & FORFEITURES

Teams must be at the field thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the game.

PLAYING TIMES

Play will proceed as specified below:
2007, 2006, 2005 – 2 x 40 min halves

2004, 2003/02- 2 x 45 min halves
Showcase: 3 guaranteed games No playoffs/final.

SCORING SYSTEM

Teams shall be awarded points on the following basis, to a maximum of 10 points per game:

- Six (6) points for each win
- Three (3) points for each tie
- Zero (0) points for a loss
- One (1) point for each shut out
- One (1) point for each goal, to a maximum of 3 per game
- 0-0 tie is scored as 4 points (3 for the tie plus 1 for a shut out)

OFFICIAL SCORES will be posted on Gotsoccer, as soon as possible after the game.

GAME CARDS: The field marshals will provide game cards to the referee prior to the start of the game. If requested, each team shall provide the marshal with an approved stamped team roster just prior to pre-game check-in. Coaches should review game cards for accuracy at the match's end and sign off on the card.

CAUTIONS AND EJECTIONS:

A player receiving two cautions (yellow cards) in a single game will be given an ejection (red card). A player who has been ejected (sent off), will not be replaced. A player who has been ejected will not return for that game and will not be allowed to participate in the next scheduled game. A player who is ejected for violent conduct or serious foul play will not be allowed to participate in the next TWO scheduled games, at a minimum. Further suspensions for Violent Conduct or Referee Abuse may be issued at the discretion of the Tournament Director or tournament official. Any player or coach who assaults a referee will be expelled from the Tournament. A coach who has been ejected (sent off) will be suspended the same as a Player ejection. During game suspension(s) for coaches: there can be NO contact between the team and the coach during the game and the coach must be out of sight and sound of the field. Additionally, the coach must not be involved in unacceptable conduct (defined as coaching his/her players by any means or method, or harassment of opponents/players/referees/staff). Failure to adhere to this rule will result an immediate ejection from the tournament for the coach.

TEAM:

The Home Team will be the team who appears first on the game schedule. HOME TEAM WEARS WHITE/or LIGHT colored jersey. The Home Team will be required to switch to alternate jerseys to accommodate a color conflict as declared by the referee. If the Home Team cannot supply alternate jerseys, the Home Team will forfeit the game. The Home Team will have the selection of the bench they wish to play from, and the direction in which they would like to play before the initial kickoff. The home team will provide 3 sanitized game balls. The game balls will be subject to Referee approval. VISITING TEAM: The Visiting Team will be the team who appears second on the game schedule and will wear DARK JERSEY. The Visiting Team shall be awarded the initial kickoff.

SPECTATORS:

All spectators are to be on the same side of the field of their Team Benches. Please read the COVID guidelines for spectators for protocols. No spectators are allowed in the teams designated area on the field.

PROHIBITIONS:

Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances is expressly prohibited at or near any of the tournament fields or complexes. No dogs or pets of any kind are allowed. No horns, bells, or noisemakers of any kind are allowed at or near the tournament fields or complexes at any time. No rude, profane, or inappropriate behavior (at the discretion of tournament officials) is allowed. Please read the COVID guidelines for spectators for addition protocols.
