All Parents must abide by the following:

- I will treat referees, players, coaches, and other spectators with the respect I would like others to give me.
- **I will attempt to understand the playing rules of soccer.**
- I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of my own personal desire to win.
- I will not yell, berate or threaten the players, coaches, referees or other spectators.
- I will not question the referee's calls.
- **I will not use profane, obnoxious language and/or behavior.**
- I will never enter the playing field. I understand that **only** coaches may enter the field, after receiving the head referee's permission.
- **I will recognize the value and importance of the volunteer coaches and referees.** They have given up their time and effort to help my child.
- I will show respect for my child's team's opponents. Without them, there would be no match.
- I will recognize positive performances by either team.
- Everyone's children watch my actions and learn from my example. I will be a good example!

By signing this form, I am agreeing to be responsible for all family and friends in attendance, who must also abide by these rules. Furthermore, my failure to comply with this agreement, or my participation in any defined conduct, will result in disciplinary action
