



## Seneca Valley North Soccer Association Mandatory Procedures for Coaches for Fall 2020 Soccer

1. You must get permission from the Club President for all activities you host besides regularly scheduled practices and games. The President will notify you of your approval or any modifications you will need to make.
2. All activities must start and end within the published scheduled time.
3. All players and coaches must wash hands/use sanitizer during all breaks in training as well as before and after the activity. Encourage players to bring their own equipment and hand sanitizer.
4. No handshakes or high fives, either during or after activities. Teams should maintain social distancing during "huddles". You can lay out cones 6 feet apart to help players maintain social distancing during breaks, instruction or team "huddles." Player equipment and personal items should be left at their cone.
5. Do **not** use the metal benches. Send players back to their cones between activities.
6. SV North will supply each player with a training vest at the beginning of the season. Do not share pinnies.
7. No post-game team snacks.
8. All return to play activities are strictly voluntary. Participation or non-participation, will not impact future team placement or standing with the club in any way
9. Parents must sign the online COVID waiver on the SV North website before players can play.
10. Coaches must clearly communicate to parents that parents must not send their players to any practice or game when, within the last 14-days:
  - a. A player has been in contact with a person with COVID-19
  - b. A player has cough, fever, or loss of taste or smell
  - c. A player has traveled out of state to any COVID hotspot identified by the PA Dept. of HealthCoaches must not allow any of these players participate unless they have subsequently been cleared to play by a doctor or a subsequent negative COVID test.
11. Only coaches may distribute or collect equipment before, during and after the training session. Players or parents should not touch equipment like cones or vests beyond what they are using.
12. Coaches need to wear masks.
13. You must communicate expectations about these procedures to parents and players.
14. It is your responsibility to follow these procedures and to ensure your assistant coaches and players also follow these procedures.
15. You must keep attendance at all practices and games. It is important to have this record to aid the PA Depart. Of Health with contact tracing in the event of an outbreak.
