



Seneca Valley North Soccer Association Fall 2020 Season Information Guide for Parents

1. **All spectators must wear a mask while at the fields.** Those from the same household may sit together. Those from different households should remain six feet apart. *This mandate applies to ALL persons and will be enforced.* If you are unable to wear a mask for medical reasons, you must contact the club president prior to the event in order to make special arrangements.
2. SV North has established procedures specifically to enable players to not have to wear masks while playing and participating. Players will be required to wear masks when attending events as a spectator (for example while watching a siblings' practice or game).
3. SV North must adhere to the 250-person limit for outdoor activities and reserves the right to limit attendance in order to adhere to this limit. We discourage those who are not immediate family members or guardians from attending events. Please do your part to keep us from having to impose stricter limits on attendance.
4. Our Concession Stand will remain closed as long as we are in the Green Phase.
5. All return to play activities are voluntary. Participation or non-participation, will not impact future team placement or standing with the club in any way
6. Parents must not send any player to any SV North activity if within the last 14-days an activity:
 - a. who has been in contact with a person with COVID-19
 - b. who has had a cough, fever, or loss of taste or smell
 - c. Who has traveled out of state to a COVID hotspot as defined by the PA Dept. of Health

Coaches are not to allow these players to participate. The only exception to these rules is that a player gets a COVID test and tests negative. Parents will be asked to produce these test results before their player is allowed to return to play.

We ask that do not have your child participate in the activity if (s)he is showing signs of any illness or you suspect has been exposed to COVID 19. Exposed players attending SV North events will result in the shutdown or suspension of club activities. Please do your part to keep your teammates and friends safe!

7. It is important that your players follow the coach's instructions to help minimize infection and maintain social distancing to the extent feasible during this activity.
8. The club has established protocols to clean and sanitize equipment before and after activities. We will need volunteers to help with cleaning and managing equipment.
9. ***All group activities come with some increased risk.***-Please read and agree to the registration waiver.
