

Kingston/Forty Fort Little League Players and Parents Code of Conduct

(adopted 1/8/18 Kingston/Forty Fort Little League Board of Directors)

Automatic Suspension

The following automatic suspensions of players shall be made and enforced by the League Commissioner. The manager or coach at a game or practice must immediately report the incident to the League Commissioner who will take the appropriate suspension action.

A suspended player may appeal the League Commissioner's suspension to the League President in writing within 48 hours of the suspension. The president will review this matter with the Board. The decision of the Board of Directors is final.

A. Fighting on the playing Field

A player who physically fights with another person on the field before, during, or after a game or practice shall receive the following suspension from the League Commissioner.

(a) First offense = Two (2) game suspension

(b) Second offense = Suspension for the remainder of the season (including playoffs and tournament play)

B. Racial/Ethnic Remarks

A player who makes racial or ethnic remarks to another person on the field before, during, or after a game or practice shall receive the following suspension from the League Commissioner:

(a) First Offense

Minimum - two (2) game suspension

Maximum - Suspension for the remainder of the season, (including playoffs and tournament play)

C. Abusive Language

A player who uses abusive language (swearing, cursing etc.) to another person before or during or after a game or practice may receive the following suspension from playing from the League Commissioner:

(a) First offense: One (1) game suspension

(b) Second offense: Two (2) game suspension

(c) Third offense: Suspension for remainder of the season (including playoffs and tournament play)

D. Parental Conduct

Parents and their guests will not engage in any kind of un-sportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or other parent such as booing, taunting, using profanity or interfering with the game in any way. Parents will show respect before, during and after games, and never question, discuss or confront umpires or coaches at the game field. Such behavior will lead to ejection from the field and possible forfeit of a game. Parents may speak to coaches or the commissioner at an agreed upon time.

E. Social Media

Players and parents will not post negative comments on social media about Little League players, coaches, umpires or other adults regarding Little League activities.

Non-Automatic Suspensions

League Commissioners have the right to suspend a player for misconduct that is not listed under the automatic suspension section of this Code of Conduct. The suspended player may exercise the same appeal process to the League President and Board of Directors as stated in the Automatic Suspension section.
