

Tampa Dynamo Return to Competitive Play Operating Procedures  
Keith Waller and Summerfield Soccer Park Action Plan

### **Cleaning**

- Disinfectants used will be recommended and approved by CDC
- Equipment used on the field by coaches will be cleaned between sessions or fresh equipment will be utilized before the use in another practice/game
- Players will be responsible for bringing their own equipment (cleats, water bottle, etc.) Other belongings brought into the field area will only be necessary for participation. (example would be sunscreen or other personal hygiene products)
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at each field for each team
- Common touch surfaces and shared objects will be cleaned between each scheduled session

### **Bathrooms and Common areas**

- Bathroom will be monitored to ensure social distancing requirements
- Bathrooms will be cleaned between sessions/games
- Common areas such as picnic tables, bleachers, etc. will remain closed and marked off for entry
- Concession stands will remain closed

### **Entry/Exit Plan**

- An identified drive in entrance/exit to the park and a designated entry/exit for each field
- A drive in/drop off area for participants will be displayed and communicated to membership (if applicable)
- Anyone who enters facility will have temperature checked upon arrival
- Staff, Volunteers, Participants and/or Parent/Guardian/Spectator will have to acknowledge answers to a CoVid-19 questionnaire before entry
  - o Questions will be sent to parents in advance
- Entrance to the park will maintain social distancing requirements
- Plan for entry and exit of the park will be sent to our membership
- Plan for parking will be sent to our membership and posted on our website
- All facilities and gates will be locked/secured after use

### **Facility Attendance**

- Roster/Attendance will be kept for each scheduled game / practice to assist with contact tracing Monitoring/Compliance
- Anyone who attends sessions at facility will enter through designated entrance area
- Only participants and staff allowed inside playing areas (field) at this time
- Participants will have a check in area at each field for training sessions
- Spectators will have designated areas to sit and watch from, maintaining social distancing policy. Area will be minimum 6 feet from playing area
- Facility attendance sheet will be kept for each training session of participants and staff at facility
- 30-minute transition time between training sessions/games

### **Monitoring/Compliance**

- There will be a site director on site for each training session scheduled at the facilities to be open to monitor usage for compliance
- Parents will monitor social distancing compliance during the practice
- Site will have a bathroom attendant to monitor social distancing and cleaning of the areas
- Site will have staff at the check-in point to conduct temperature checks and acknowledge answers to CoVid-19 questionnaire

### **Return to Play**

- There will be a weekly training schedule that is distributed for the upcoming practice sessions
- Group, parent or team meetings will be online until further notice
- Practice session
  - o No team huddles
  - o No player contact (i.e. high fives, handshakes, etc.)
  - o Minimizing of shared equipment
- Coaches will be required to wear masks

### **Safety**

- *Inclement Weather Plan*
  - o We will provide cancellation of events with adequate time before the start of the scheduled event if inclement weather is expected
  - o If inclement weather forces a clearing of the fields during a training session, the participants will return to their cars and that training session will be cancelled
  - o If inclement weather forces a clearing of the fields during the first scheduled event of a night, the second scheduled practice for the night will be cancelled
  - o If inclement weather occurs during a game, the fields will be cleared with participants returning to their vehicles and the decision to return to the fields will be with the site marshal depending on the safety protocols.
  - o In the case of players returning to the fields after weather delay, social distancing will be maintained and all participants will apply hand sanitizer on re-entry to the park.
  - o Parents will be required to stay at the fields during their participants scheduled practice/game
  - o If a participant's parent is unavailable to take children home, indoor facilities will be opened up for safety. Parents will be contacted for pickup
  - o Indoor facilities will be pre-setup to ensure social distancing requirements can be maintained

### **Staff, Coaches and Volunteers**

- Will have temperature checked upon arrival
- Will be asked CoVid Questionnaire questions
- Will have attendance taken
- Will be required to have masks until further notice
- Will be trained in new operational procedures

### **Spectators/Parents**

- Parents will be encouraged to remain in vehicles when possible
  - o If parents chose to watch training / games, he or she must
    - Stay off the playing field
    - Maintain social distancing between other families
    - No intermingling of groups.
- Family groups sizes will be restricted to 10 people or less.
- Facial coverings/ masks must be worn for all non-playing persons upon entry to the park and during sessions.
- Spectator/Parent area will be labeled on field map
- Each facility will have designated spectator area for each field where social distancing will apply
- Parent/spectator must adhere to below for attendance at facility
  - o Have temperature checked at check-in site
  - o Answer Covid-19 questionnaire questions
  - o Bring their own chair, snacks, water, etc.
  - o Adhere to strict social distancing guidelines
  - o Spectator/Parent area will be labeled on field map

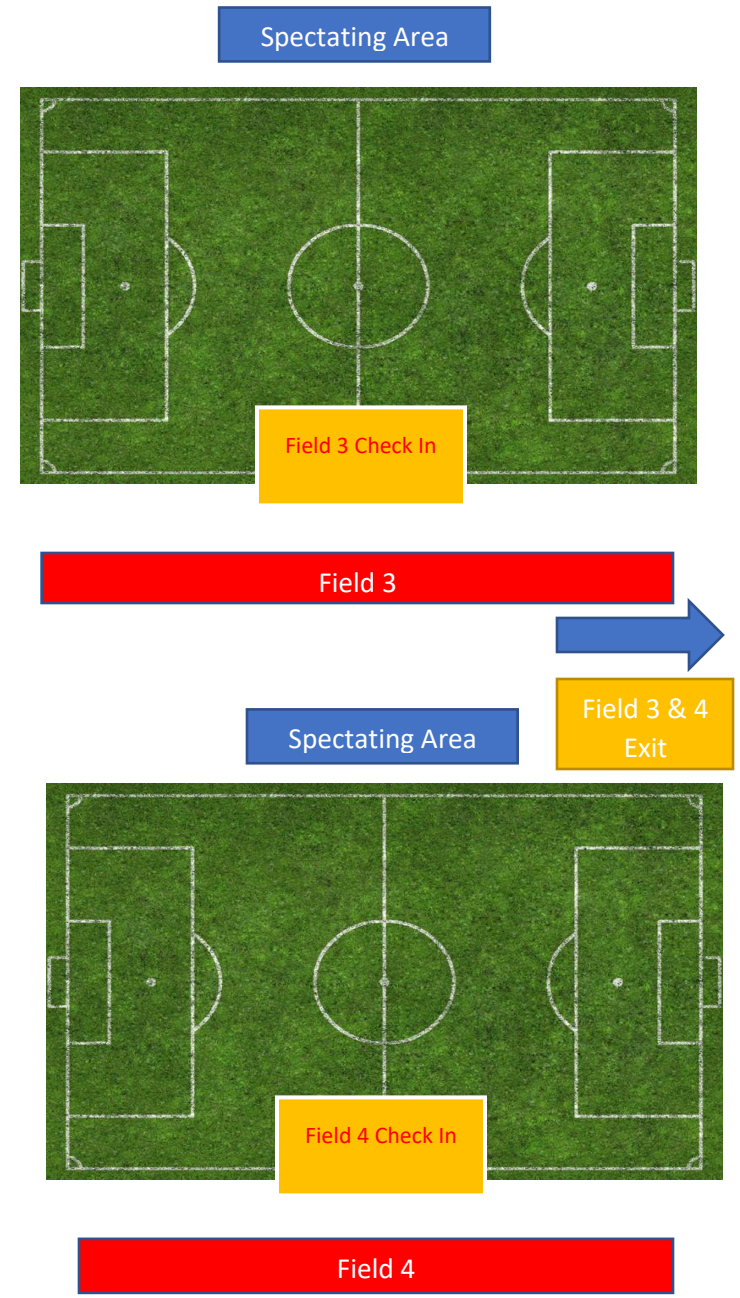
### **CoVid-19 Reporting**

- Procedure posted on our website
- Procedure emailed to our membership
- CoVid-19 case reporting procedure
  - o A positive case of CoVid-19 must be reported to Director of Soccer Operations
    - Case will be documented, and player will be identified on roster/attendance sheet for no participation until cleared by Director of Soccer Operations
    - TDFC will notify HCPRD Athletics office
  - o Player will be notified of below procedure before they can return
    - No return to play in accordance with CDC guidelines
    - A doctor's note will be needed to be cleared to participate again
  - o Membership will be notified of a positive case and when that participant was at the facility
  - o Facility will be cleaned and disinfected

### **CoVid-19 Questionnaire**

- Participant and/or Parent/Guardian/Spectator will have to acknowledge answers to these questions upon entrance to facility
- 1) Have you had a sore throat, fever, ached in the past 24 hours?
- 2) Has anyone in your household been ill?
- 3) Have you been around anyone with a confirmed CoVid case?
- 4) Has anyone in your household traveled outside of the country in the past month?

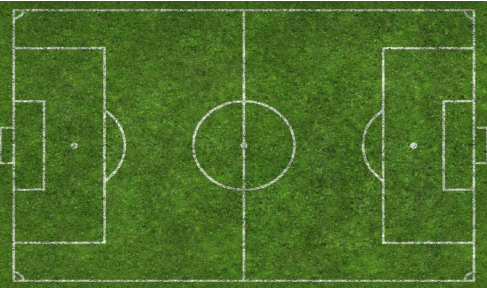


KEITH WALLER PARK GAME DAY LAYOUT

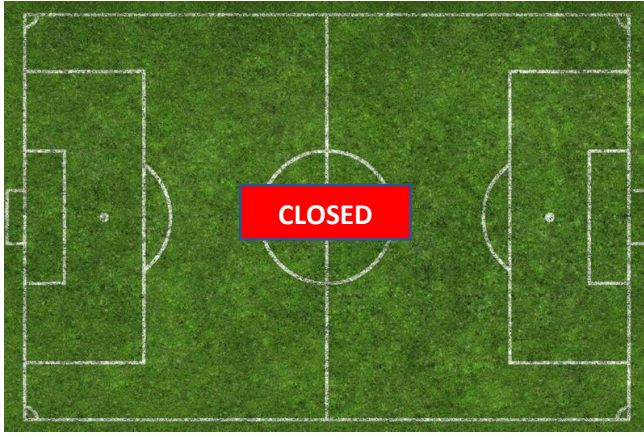

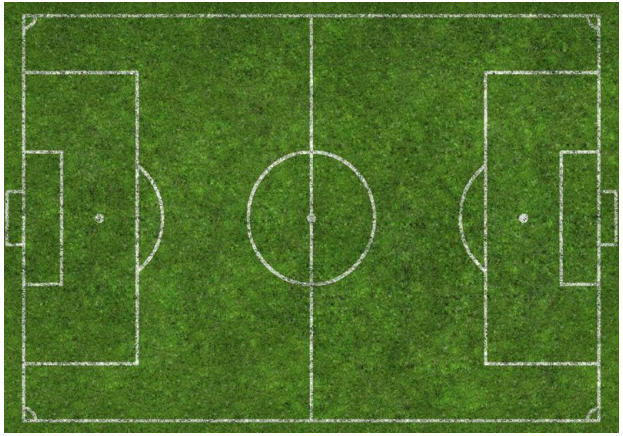

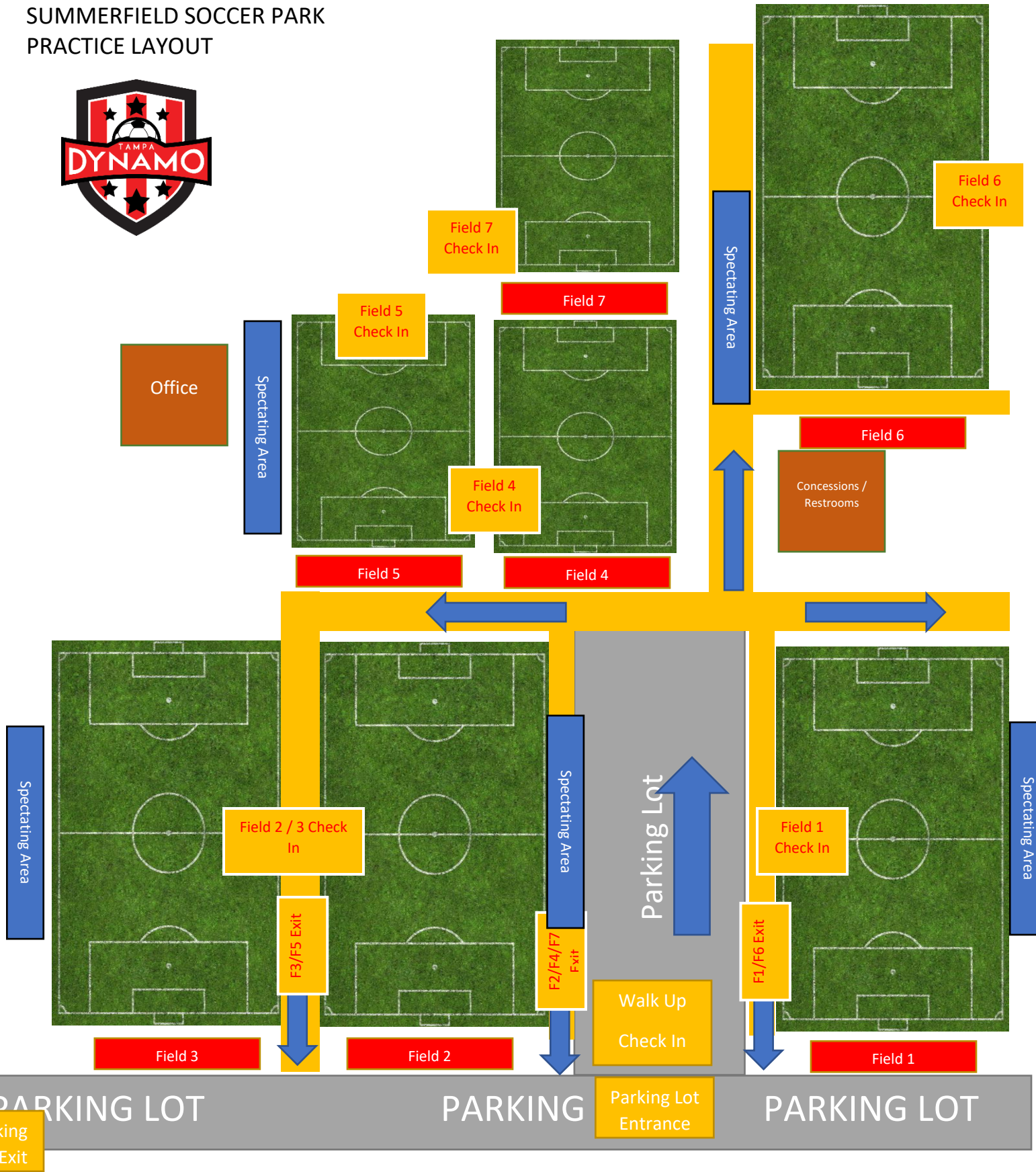
