Mudsock Youth Field Hockey 2020 Fall Recreational Field Hockey

Join Mudsock Youth Field Hockey for our 2020 Fall recreational season. We offer a full recreational field hockey program for players in grades 2nd through early 11th who reside in the Hamilton Southeastern School District. **Non-residents may still register with an additional fee**. All recreational field hockey participants will be registered through the Mudsock Youth Athletic Office.

Registration Fees

Open fall registration will be held the month of May. Registrations will be accepted online at myathletics.com and in-person at the Mudsock Youth Athletics office. Fall fees will be \$120 for returning players and \$135 for new players (which includes a field hockey starter package). There will be a multi-player discount available for families registering. A \$10 late fee will be added to each registration after May 31st, 2020.

*Due to Covid-19, there will be a revised registration period for fall 2020 programming.

Season Highlights

The season will run for nine weeks from early August until the first week of October. It will consist of a midweek practice and Saturday game. Participants will receive team information at least two weeks prior to their first practice. Practices will be held on weeknights, while the majority of games will be held on Saturday. Every attempt will be made to reschedule any canceled games due to weather or field conditions for the following Sunday afternoon (8 days post with the exception of holidays).

Coach Information

All of our teams are coached by former Division I, II and III field hockey athletes and volunteers. Please keep this in mind throughout the season. *Persons interested in coaching or volunteering in any capacity (we LOVE volunteers!) can mark their intent on their child's online registration form or email fishersfh@gmail.com directly. You do not have to have experience to volunteer. All volunteers are required to submit a background check, complete online concussion and Safe Sport training. Coaches are required to attend a preseason coach's meeting. Please also list on the registration form if you are interested in being a league sponsor or volunteering on the field hockey board. We would love to have you.*

Mudsock Youth Field Hockey divides players into beginner and advanced divisions based on their ability and experience. Please register for the player's current grade during the 2020-2021 school year.

Payments/Refunds

A player is not considered registered with Mudsock Youth Field Hockey until payment is

received or other arrangements have been made through the Mudsock Youth Athletics office. Scholarships are available during open registration for those children who qualify for free and reduced school lunch.

Player Equipment

Mudsock Field Hockey will provide a team jersey. It is not possible for the league to order individually sized uniforms due to the ordering process/timeline. Players are responsible for bringing the following items to each practice and game:

- Shin guards: Players may not participate without shin guards.
- Mouthguard: Players may not participate without a mouthguard.
- **Footwear:** Athletic shoes/cleats. No player may participate while wearing shoes with a toe cleat, (i.e. baseball cleats).
- Stick and ball
- Ample supply of fresh water

Please note, Mudsock Field Hockey will host a **Field Hockey Day for returning** players to purchase sticks and additional equipment as well as buyback/swap their old equipment. Coaches will be onsite to size athletes and recommend the appropriate stick for their skill level. Date and location TBA.

Players are **NOT** permitted to wear jewelry during practice or games. Players should not pierce their ears in close proximity to the season as the earrings and other jewelry will have to be removed to play.
