Team Camp – Pre-season mini – team camp. Team Training 4 days in a row to kick off season (Both fall and spring)

Fall:

- Director's Academy; 8-10 games (depending on number of teams in division)
- Tournaments; 1 Tournament Included in Team Fees, 1 additional tournament (not covered in team fees)
- Training: 3x per week, 2 90 minute team training sessions and 1 DOC session at Marino's Fields
- Access to goalkeeper training once per week

1v1 Dominance Camp, November 4th-week of 18th; at Jackson High school

- 6 Sessions, 60-minutes
- Sessions lead and organized by Technical Director, U11-U12 team coaches leading activities and small sided games
- Focuses on becoming 1v1 dominant through understanding different types of pressure (in front, behind, on the side, and off the ball)
- Players rotate through 3 different stations: technical habit, 1v1 outplay, and small sided games.

Winter:

Focus will be on Futsal

- Futsal is amazing for player development as the conditions of the sport force players to play in tight spaces, making them more technical, helping them learn to transition faster, and to be more creative in finding solutions to the problems players will face. Plus, it is a lot of fun!

Details:

- Jackson Futsal League (**included in club fees**) 7 games played on Friday evenings or Sunday afternoons/evenings
- 1 training session per week, beginning January 4th-March 1st, 9 60-minute training sessions at different local locations lead by team coach
- Access to goalkeeper training once per week
- 1 Player evaluation with team coach to update player on progress with intention of inspiring the player to want to improve and love the game more

* As a club, we think it important for players to have the opportunities to participate in other sports and activities. We feel with only 1 training session and game per week, players will have the opportunity to participate in other things they feel passionate about.

Spring:

- Director's Academy; 8-10 games (depending on number of teams in division)
- Junior State Cup (3 games guaranteed, knockout stages if qualify)
- Tournaments; Michigan Club Challenge: End of April (**included in club fees**) & Canton Cup: Memorial Day Weekend
- Training: 3x per week, 2 Team Sessions and 1 DOC Session at Marino's Fields
- Access to goalkeeper training once per week

Rush tutor program - additional opportunity in both fall, winter, and spring sessions

For players who want more - Players will have access to the Rush tutor program which allows Rush players to train as much as they want with other Rush teams. Upon coach's recommendation, players will train up, or down, an age group to give them an appropriate level of play. This may be used to challenge a player, or, give a player the additional confidence they need.

*Club Administration Fee: includes all club coaching staff. Full time Director of Coaching, GK Director of Coaching, Team Staff Coach, Team Assistant Coach, and Club CPA Fees.

**NSA Fee: Allows players access to Rush Soccer programs including Rush Select, Rush Festival and Michigan Rush Festival, Player Loan Program, College Advisory Program, Rush Respect and Rush Juggling Club amongst others.

Monthly Payment Plan:

\$279.8 (20%) paid at registration prior to July 15th 2020

\$139.9 (10%) paid on August, September, October, November and December 15th 2020, January, February, and March 15th 2021

PLEASE NOTE:

- Initial Registration Deadline July 15th, 2020
- Players not registered online with initial payment complete by July 15th will be subject to \$69.95 late fee.
- Refund Policy
There are no refunds. If you would like to drop out of the program an email must be sent to the club outlining the reasoning behind your family's decision to part ways with Rush Jackson. After receiving your email your account will be deactivated within 30 days.
- Failure to Pay Policy
If your account falls 30 days behind, you will be notified. Upon notification you will have 5 business days to rectify your account with Rush Jackson/First Touch. After which:
 - i. Your child's passcard will be pulled, which will prohibit them from participating in any MI Rush activities until payments have been received. Once your account is balanced the passcard will be reinstated.
 - ii. You will be subject to a \$69.95 late fee.
