



IOWA RUSH POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR RUSH FEST FUNDRAISING

Iowa Rush Soccer Club provides the opportunity for all 12U Select Program players to participate in the annual Rush Fest each summer. The Rush Fest event location, dates, and times are decided by the Rush Soccer National organization. This is an optional event for players to attend, and in no way has influence on team selection, etc.

As Rush Fest is typically held a considerable distance from Iowa, the cost of the trip can be significant and will vary from year-to-year dependent on location, cost of travel, number of players attending, etc. To assist with this cost, the Iowa Rush Soccer Club does allow the 12U Boys and Girls Select teams to fundraise to offset the cost of the trip to the player/team. In order to allow the fundraising efforts to be clear, honest, and appropriate, the following procedures must be followed:

1. Rush Fest fundraising efforts are to offset the cost of Rush Fest and not to be used for any other event or cause.
2. All fundraising items, events, etc. must be approved by the Iowa Rush Soccer Club, including any product that will be produced with the Iowa Rush name or Rush logo.
3. All fundraising efforts must be targeted to offset the cost of Rush Fest for the player only, and NOT family members, which include parents and siblings.
4. All fundraising efforts must be offered out to ALL eligible-age Select Program players to participate.
5. All fundraising efforts must be clearly identified as "Group" or "Individual", so that players and their families understand that the money earned will go directly towards the individual player, or split among the entire pool of players attending.
6. Players will be allowed to raise a MAXIMUM of \$1,000.00 per individual, regardless of the price of the trip. Any amount over \$1,000.00 for an individual will be automatically placed into the "Group" fund and split evenly among the remaining players attending the event who have not exceeded the \$1,000.00 per individual maximum.
7. A volunteer from either the Boys or Girls side must track ALL individual fundraisers, as the club will NOT track individual Rush Fest fundraising efforts throughout the year.
8. Funds raised may be given and deposited to the Iowa Rush Soccer Club at any point throughout the year, and those who have raised through "Individual" fundraisers will be provided a credit to their Rush Fest registration account once final registration and pricing have been established.
9. Any individual fundraising efforts made by a player that has chosen to NOT attend will be automatically added to the "Group" fund and split evenly among the players attending the event who have not exceeded the \$1,000.00 per individual maximum.
