MN RUSH RETURN TO PLAY RESPONSIBILITIES



PLAYERS

- If you are not feeling well, stay home!
- Maintain proper social distancing at all times.
- Water and personal equipment should not be shared and should be placed 6-feet apart on the sidelines.
- Player bags should be placed on the sideline at intervals of 6-feet apart.
- Pack hand sanitizer to use before, during, and after training.
- Get on and off the fields as quickly as possible
- Bring your own soccer ball and water.
- Do not touch communal equipment.
- Players are required to wear a mask to and from their vehicle.

PARENTS

- If you think your player is sick, keep them home! If a coach has a concern about your player's health, you will be called to pick up your player.
- Spectators are not allowed on the field. You should remain in your vehicle or leave after player drop-off.
- Do not drop players off more than 15 minutes early to practice.
- Parents are encouraged to maintain social distancing on the sidelines
- Pack hand sanitizer in your player(s) bag.
- Parents are encouraged to limit the number of family members attending the game.

COACHES

- If you feel sick, stay home!
- Disinfect equipment before and after training.
- Maintain proper social distancing at all times.
- Wear a mask when greeting players but it is optional during training.
- Monitor water breaks to ensure social distancing.
- Ensure that player bags will be placed at intervals of 6-feet apart.
- Use hand sanitizer before, during, and after training.
- Encourage players to get on and off the fields as quickly as possible.
- Limit handing out equipment and do not allow the players to share.
- Coaches are required to wear a mask during games
- Coaches will help enforce social distancing on the sidelines

MN RUSH Board

- Will distribute hand sanitizer to each coach to be used on player hands and equipment before, during, and after training (if individual players do not have their own).
- Leadership Staff and Board Members may be asked to patrol the fields to assure everyone is safe and following the social distancing guidelines.
- Leadership Staff and Board Members may be asked to disrupt groups of people congregating around the fields or park.
