



Advanced Coach Course Section 1 Policy

The Section Coach Administrator must approve all Advanced Coach Courses.

The course objective is to have a minimum of 10 coaches for it to proceed and two AYSO Coach Instructors as there needs to be discussions groups lead by an instructor.

The lead instructor must have an AYSO Advanced Coach Instructor certification and the other instructor has to be at minimum a qualified AYSO Coach Instructor that has the Advanced Coach Course certification.

The goal of this course is to offer the Advanced Coach Course candidates an opportunity to observe & evaluate players at the 16-U/19-U level by viewing videos of games or 11 v 11 full field analysis of a live match.

If the course roster drops below the 10 minimum limit one week before the course date both the lead coach instructor and the coach course administrator must contact the Section Coach Administrator.

Based on the information provided the Section Coach Administrator will decide if the course goes forward or not.

Prerequisites-Coach

- Completion of the Intermediate/14U Coach Course (1 year or season in grade)
- Are currently registered as a AYSO Volunteer
- Have received Safe Haven certification.
- CDC Concussion Awareness Training (State Law in California).
