

Area 12-A U-10 thru U-19 Interplay Game Schedule Guidelines

1. The following disclaimer will be added to the Registration Form for all players

Parents: Due to the changes across our country in **ALL** sports, Regions may develop “inter-play” over “in-house” schedules to increase the variety of matches. In AYSO we strive to focus on our children’s enjoyment of the game, therefore your Region may consider “interplay” in our Area for U10 and up. Great lengths are taken to limit the amount of travel around the Area.

By checking the following box you indicate that you have read and understood the previous paragraph.



2. U-10 and above Coaches need to sign an agreement that their team may be required to travel to participate in the Area 12-A Interplay program and the coach will need to agree to adhere to the schedule by attending all games no matter where they are scheduled.
3. If a coach or team decides NOT to participate in any scheduled match due to other conflicts, the coach must notify their own Regional Commissioner at least 5 days prior to the scheduled game, re-schedule the game at the original location, and complete the game that takes place on the re-scheduled date and time – there will be no punitive sanction against that coach or team.
4. In the event the coach notified their Regional Commissioner less than 5 days prior to a scheduled game, that team will lose their ability to participate in the Area Tournament and each occurrence of this event will qualify as one infraction against the team each time it occurs.
5. If two infractions of this stipulation occur, then that team is immediately removed from the Area 12-A Interplay schedule, and the Regional Commissioner (from the offending coaches Region) has the right to remove that coach from the team, replace them by assigning another coach in their place, or disband the team simply refunding the players registration fees according to the

P&P of that Region. If the coach is successfully replaced, then the team will NOT be removed from the Area 12-A Interplay schedule, (but remains ineligible for Area Tournament) and will continue to play the rest of the regularly scheduled games.

In the event that the Coach refuses to travel without just cause, then the two strike rule does not apply, and the Regional Commissioner of the offending coach is authorized to immediately remove the coach, and replace them with a new coach, or if that option is not available, to disband the team and simply refund the players registration fees according to that Region's P&P.
