### 2019 TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

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<b>Dates:</b>	June 14-16, 2019
<b>Location:</b>	Greenville, MI 6596 Vining Rd
<b>Registration Date:</b>	Entries must be received by May 24 <sup>th</sup> .
<b>Registration Fee:</b>	U-10 through U-19 \$100/Team (no refunds after May 31 <sup>st</sup> , 2019).
<b>Referee Deposit:</b>	None. Each region is encouraged to supply at least 4 referees who will officiate at least 3 games each. Referee support from each region is essential to the success of this tournament.
<b>Payments:</b>	Payments to: AYSO 1471—AREA A 5V5 TOURNAMENT Checks must be drawn on an AYSO Regional account.
<b>Who Can Register:</b>	AYSO-Area 8/A registered players. Player must have played on a house team during the current 2018/2019 season. Roster must be signed by your Regional Commissioner. All players must be from the same Region. Players must be at least 10U division. No 8U players. Teams from other Areas may be accepted to fill brackets.
<b>Format:</b>	Round-Robin type format with Semi-Final and Championship games for divisions with more than one bracket. Each team will play a minimum of three games.
<b>DIVISIONS:</b>	10U Boys and Girls, 5 v 5, maximum 7 players on roster. 12U Boys and Girls, 5 v 5, maximum 7 players on roster. 14U Boys and Girls, 5 v 5, maximum 7 players on roster. 19U Boys and Girls, 5 v 5, maximum 7 players on roster.
<b>Age Cut-Off Date:</b>	The cut-off date for each division will be the same as AYSO for the season immediately preceding the tournament.
<b>Awards:</b>	Awards will be given to the top four teams from each division & the top 3 overall costumes.
<b>Proceeds:</b>	Proceeds will be used for regional development and improvement.
<b>Concessions:</b>	Will be provided by Flo's Pizzeria.

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5v5 TOURNAMENT – RULES

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**PLAYER REGISTRATION:**

1. Each player will be required to have their signed player registration form. If the player is under 18, their parent or legal guardian will be required to sign the player registration form. By signing the registration form you acknowledge that AYSO and tournament committee is not responsible for lost or stolen property or any injury that may occur during the tournament. Proof of age of each player is required. (If any player's age is challenged, that player will be required to present proof of date of birth to the tournament officials. Failure to provide proof will result in forfeit of the game.)
2. Only AYSO Area 8/A players may register. Each player must have played on a house team during the regular MY season. All players must be from the same Region, and the roster must be signed by the team's Regional Commissioner. Players must be at least 10U division with no 8U players; even if the 8U player played up for the MY season. Teams from other AYSO Areas may be accepted to fill brackets if need be.
3. Deadline for submitting an amended roster will be at tournament registration prior to your first game.

**NUMBER OF PLAYERS:**

1. Seven (7) is the maximum number of players on a team
2. (4) players on the Field plus (1) goal keeper
3. Minimum Number of Players to Start Match: 4, one of whom shall be a goalkeeper
4. Players may only play on one team.
4. Substitutes may occur at any dead ball situation, but players must enter and exit at the half- field mark only.

**EQUIPMENT & UNIFORMS:**

1. Luau/Summer Themed costumes are STRONGLY encouraged, and awards will be issued for best costumes.
2. Matching uniform/costumes with alternate goalkeeper color are required. Uniforms must be the same color.
3. Appropriate soccer footwear and shin guards are mandatory.

## **FIELD DIMENSIONS:**

### U10 & U12 Playing Field:

- Approx 130' (length) x 80' (width)
- Penalty boxes: 8 yards (length) x 15 yards (width)
- Offensive third and line of confrontation 10 yards out and across entire field
- Goals: 6.5' x 12'
- Size 4 Ball

### U14 & U19 Playing Field

- Approx 145' (length) x 90 (width)
- Penalty box: 10 yards (length) x 18 yards (width)
- Offensive third and line of confrontation 12 yards out and across entire field
- Goals: 6.5' x 12'
- Size 5 Ball

## **MATT DePAUW LUAU TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

1. Round-Robin type format with Semi-Final and Championship games for divisions with more than one bracket. Each team will play a minimum of three games. Point system:
  - a. Win: 3 Points
  - b. Tie: 2 Points
  - c. Loss: 1 Point
  - d. Forfeit: 0 Points
2. #1 Seed for playoffs goes to the team with the largest point total
3. Tie Breakers:
  - a. Total Wins
  - b. Goal Differential
  - c. Goals Allowed
  - d. Play-In Game – First Team to Score wins
4. Playoffs: Any ties after regulation will be settled by a penalty shootout
  - a. Ball will be placed at the designated PK line
  - b. Team leading after 4 kicks win.
  - c. If tied after 4 kicks each team takes 1 kick until only one team scores
  - d. All players must have a turn to shoot before the order can be reset.

## **GAME RULES**

- 1.** Unless denoted in this document, current FIFA rules apply. They can be found at the FIFA website, under Laws of the Game.
  - 2.** DURATION OF THE GAME: Two equal periods of 10 minutes.
  - 3.** Half-time: 3 minutes
  - 4.** Substitution Limit: None
  - 5.** There is no Offsides.
  - 6.** Throw-Ins: Are indirect kick-ins, defending team must be at least 15' away.
  - 7.** RESTART TIME LIMIT – Restart must take place within 5 seconds or the ball is awarded to the opposing team (enforcement to take place gradually).
  - 8.** At the referee's discretion, a team that intentionally kicks a ball out of bounds or fails to retrieve a ball in a prompt manner, for the purpose of allowing time to expire will be warned. A second violation will result in a penalty kick.
  - 9.** Corner Kicks: Are direct kicks. Defenders must be 5 yards from the ball.
  - 10.** Goal Kicks: Must be taken from a stationary ball anywhere inside the penalty box. All opposing players must be outside of the penalty box.
  - 11.** Goal Keeper Distribution: All other goal keeper distributions must bounce or be touched by another player before crossing the halfway line. Violation will result in the award of a free kick were the ball crossed the line. No punting.
  - 12.** Pass backs cannot be picked up by the goal keeper, but the goal keeper can play the ball with their feet anywhere on the field.
  - 13.** No Heading
  - 14.** Penalty Kicks: Penalty kicks will be given for fouls and misconduct that are penalized under the FIFA Rules with a direct kick if the foul is committed by a defensive player against an offensive player while in the offensive player's half of the field.
    - a. Any of the following offenses considered by the referee to be careless, reckless or using excessive force:
      - i. Kicks or attempts to kick an opponent
      - ii. Trips or attempts to trip an opponent
      - iii. Charges an opponent
      - iv. Strikes or attempts to strike an opponent
      - v. Pushes an opponent.
    - b. Defensive hand balls inside the penalty box
  - 15.** Penalty Kick: The ball is dead when its forward momentum ends. Play will restart with an indirect kick at midfield.
    - a. Goal scored – Indirect kick taken by opposing team
    - b. No goal – Indirect kick taken by team that took penalty kick
  - 16.** Indirect Kick will be awarded to the opposing team for any foul that does not result in a penalty kick. Opposing team must stand 5 yards from ball.
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17. Defensive walls 5 yards from spot of ball.

### **SPORTSMANSHIP**

1. A referee reserves the right to eject any player whose behavior at any time during the tournament endangers another player, referee, or the public. The tournament committee has the right to extend the ejection multiple games or the entire tournament in its discretion.
2. The referee, at their discretion, has the right to eject any fan or team volunteer who act in a threatening or unsportsmanlike manner or uses abusive language.
3. Players and team volunteers will sit on one side of the field, while spectators for both sides will be on the other side of the field. Spectators will not be permitted to sit on the player side of the field.
