

ADDENDUM B – ADDITIONAL REGIONAL POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

1.0 PLAYER REGISTRATION – REGISTRATION FEE POLICY

- A full registration fee refund shall be granted until a player participates in a practice or game.
- If a player participates in a practice or a game, no registration fee refund is available.

2.0 UNIFORMS - UNIFORM FEE POLICY

- Uniforms shall be purchased as an additional fee (in addition to the registration fee) at a local retailer. This requirement shall be mentioned in all places where the registration fee is listed. This promotes availability of uniforms for late registrants, is consistent with local marketplace practices, and prevents mis-ordering due to eAYSO registration system limitations (cannot require new sizes to be input each year and parents don't update the fields).
- Uniform styles and colors are only those approved by the Regional Board. No exceptions are granted and no unique uniforms are to be ordered by coaches or other members of the Region.

3.0 PLAYER DIVISIONS - DIVISION POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

- Gender: All divisions will be gender specific, where enough players exist. Common exceptions include u-5 and certain u-6 teams.
- Play Up / Play Down Requests: Managed by the Regional Board and on a case by case basis.

4.0 SCHOLARSHIPS – SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

- Registration: If a parent cannot afford the registration fee, we allow their child to play free of charge no questions asked. Our region has very few of these requests. We ask that they maintain the uniform obligation themselves.
- College: Annually, scholarships to high schoolers rising to college may be granted at the sole discretion of the regional board. Generally, one (1) scholarship per school district is granted for a total of two (2) scholarships.
- Other Board Scholarships: From time to time, an additional college scholarship may be warranted, or players may be designated for "permanent" registrations scholarship for example if a parent has passed away who volunteered for our program. The Regional Board may grant other scholarships at their sole discretion.
