

## 8 Indirect Free Kick Offenses

<p>The <b>Goalkeeper</b> offenses. (can only be committed by the GK within the GK's own penalty area)</p>	<p>Controls the ball with hands for more than 6 seconds.</p>
	<p>Touches the ball <b>again</b> with hands <b>after releasing it</b> and before it touches another player.</p>
	<p>Touches the ball with hands after is has been <b>deliberately kicked</b> to them <b>by a teammate.</b></p>
	<p>Touches the ball with hands after receiving it <b>directly</b> from a throw-in taken <b>by a teammate.</b></p>
<p>By <b>any player</b> anywhere on the field</p>	<p>Playing in a <b>dangerous manner</b> [whether to self or others if it unfairly interferes with an opponent].</p>
	<p><b>Impedes</b> the progress of an opponent [When no within playing distance of the ball] without contact.</p>
	<p><b>Prevents</b> the <b>goalkeeper</b> from releasing the ball from their hands</p>
<p>The "catch all" provision.</p>	<p>Commits any other offense, not previously mentioned in Law 12, for which play is stopped to caution or send off a player.</p>
