14U Coach Training

Thank you for volunteering. It's super fun. To prepare for becoming a 14U Coach you will need first be certified as a 12U Coach and then take the additional courses below. Both the head and assistant coach must complete these requirements. Successful completion of this education, and passing the annual background check process will make you eligible to be assigned to coach a 14U team.

1. **AYSO's Safe Haven**
2. **CDC: Concussion Course**
3. **Intermediate Coaching Course - Online Course**
4. **Intermediate Coach – In-Person Course**

The first three courses listed above are completed entirely online. The online Intermediate Coaching Training course must be completed before you attend the In-Person Intermediate Coach course. **Additionally, you must have previously completed all certification requirements for coaching at the 12U level before taking the Intermediate Coach Course.**

All courses are accessed through AYSO U Online Learning Resources. The instructions below will show you how to navigate to and through the site. Logging in properly will automatically add your course completions to your AYSO profile. Online courses vary in length, but most take 30-45 minutes each to complete.

Accessing AYSO U - Online Learning Resources

1. Go to the Region 418 website: www.ayso418.org
2. Click on "AYSOU" in the Region 418 homepage toolbar.
3. New volunteers click "**here to learn more**" on that page to get started. Returning volunteers click "**Login**". Log into AYSOU with the same login as for your volunteer account at www.ayso418.org.

Accessing **AYSO's Safe Haven Course in the AYSO U Portal**

1. You only need to take Safe Haven one time in your coaching career (although we recommend you review yearly)- so returning coaches just double check you have it already.
2. On the "Home" screen click "Online Courses".
3. Click the "Open" button to the right of the course called **AYSO's Safe Haven**.
 - There are 7 modules, plus an exam for the Safe Haven the course.
 - Each module can be completed in 5-10 minutes.
 - If you are unable to complete the course in one sitting, AYSO U will remember your progress and you can pick back up where you left off.

- Click the "Launch" button to the right of each module in succession through the end of the course.
- You will need to answer at least 80% of the questions correctly to pass the course.
- You will have the ability to review and retry the quiz at the end as may be needed/desired.
- Print out your completion certificate for your records. Your completion will automatically be added to your volunteer profile.
- All AYSO volunteers, regardless of position within the organization, must complete this course. And all AYSO volunteers are expected to be aware of and prioritize our program philosophies, and protection guidelines for safety and injury prevention.

Accessing **CDC: Concussion Course in the AYSO U Portal**

1. You only need to take the CDC concussion one time in your coaching career (although we recommend you review yearly)- so returning coaches just double check you have it already.
2. On the "Home" screen click "Online Courses"
3. Click the "Open" button to the right of the course called **CDC: Concussion Course**.
4. Click the "Launch" button.
5. A new window will open, as long as you do not have a pop-up blocker on in your computer's settings.
6. Enter your Blue Sombrero account User Name and click "Submit." This is the same username you use to access your volunteer account at www.ayso418.org.
 - The course is divided into 5 modules.
 - The video modules are approximately 5-10 minutes long, with a short quiz at the conclusion of each.
 - If you are unable to complete the course in one sitting, AYSO U will remember your progress and you can pick back up where you left off.
 - Click the yellow buttons on the clipboard on the left to progress through the course.
 - Print out your completion certificate for your records. Your completion will automatically be added to your volunteer profile.

Accessing the **Online Intermediate Coaching Training Course in the AYSO U Portal**

Note - You must complete this online course *prior* to attending the In-Person course.

1. On the "Home" screen click "Online Courses".
2. Click the "Open" button to the right of the course called **Intermediate Coaching Training**.
 - The course is divided into modules, plus an exam.
 - Most modules can be completed in 7-10 minutes.
 - If you are unable to complete the course in one sitting, AYSO U will remember your progress and you can pick back up where you left off.

- Click the "Launch" button to the right of each module in succession through the end of the course.
- You will need to answer at least 80% of the questions correctly to pass the course.
- You will have the ability to review and retry the quiz at the end as may be needed/desired.
- Print out your completion certificate for your records. Your completion will automatically be added to your profile.

Accessing the Intermediate Coach – In-Person Course in the AYSO U Portal

1. On the "Home" screen click "In-Person Courses"
2. Open the "Coach Instructor Led Courses".
3. Click the "Sessions" button to the right of Intermediate Coach to see all available sessions.
4. Find a session being offered in the Chicago area and "Register" to attend the class. You may attend any Intermediate Coach session that fits your schedule, regardless of the region or area sponsoring the class.
5. Click the title of the course for detailed information about the class location, name of the instructor and parking.
6. If you need to Unregister for a session, click the title of the course for which you are registered, and you will be able to access the blue "Unregister" button.
7. If none of the available sessions fit your schedule, contact Coach.Admin@ayso418.org
Our Coach Administrator will work with you to find or schedule a session that will work for you.

Verification

Once you have completed your classes please double check your profile to see if it shows up. This may not be instantaneous for the online courses, and the instructors of the in-person course must enter your course completion manually before your certification will show in your volunteer account.
