

AYSO Standard Regional Policies & Protocols - Additional Addendum Items

Article	Paragraph	Change
6	D	<p>Email Voting</p> <p>It is understood that at times situations or issues may arise that require a decision by the Regional Board prior to the next scheduled Board Meeting. As such, the Regional Commissioner may, at his/her discretion, call for a vote via E-mail response on any matter he/she deems cannot wait until the next Board Meeting as long as the matter does not require a change in the Policies and Protocols; and waiting until the next meeting would be impractical and undesirable; and it must be seconded; and discussion via E-mail, with all Board Members copied and included, must be allowed for a minimum of 3 days prior to final vote; and determination is made by a majority decision of the Board Members voting on any such matter.</p>
7	B.1	<p>Registration Fee Refund Policy</p> <p>Refunds for those not playing will be made as long as – 1) The player has not participated in either a training session or game AND 2) has not yet received a uniform AND 3) a request for a refund has been made in writing (email is acceptable) PRIOR to the first game. This refund policy doesn't apply to the AYSO EXTRA program. All payments for the AYSO EXTRA program are non-refundable.</p>
7	B.2	<p>Team Assignments Based upon Grade</p> <p>A player may be placed in a division with players of their grade level in school and may not be based on birthdate</p>
7	B.4	<p>Participation Requirement</p> <p>No player plays a full game until all players play three-fourths, whenever possible.</p>
7	B.8	<p>Volunteer Requests</p> <p>Volunteers may request to be "paired" as Head Coach and Assistant Coach for the same team (with their children assigned thereto) as long as such "pairing" is either in the best interest of or will not adversely effect the players, team(s), division and Region as determined by the Regional Commissioner. Members of the same household are not eligible to be the Head and Assistant Coaches for the same team.</p>
7	B.9	<p>Requests for Age Division Change</p> <p>Should a parent or guardian request that their player be moved to an age division older than the age division the player would normally be in the request for this "Move-Up" shall be submitted to the Regions "Move-Up Committee" consisting of the RC, RCA and CVPA. Requests to move a player to an age division younger than the age division the player would normally be in will not be accepted. In order to be considered for a Move-Up the player must be currently registered and</p>

		<p>fees paid and have played in the immediate past season. Registration and written request by parent/guardian must be made prior to the end of regular registration and before the start of "Late Registration". No requests will be accepted where volunteer status is predicated on the player being moved-up. Guidelines and items to be taken into consideration by the Move-Up Committee include maturity, size (height/weight), rating (past season required, previous seasons may be considered), consultation with immediate past season's coach, effect on team and division, and what's in the best interest of the child. Items that shall not be considered include sibling(s) placement, parent(s) or player's volunteer status, and years in AYSO. A final decision will be made by the majority of the Move-Up Committee.</p>
7	B	<p>Pet Policy</p> <p>No pets are permitted at any region event, practice, or game.</p>
8	P	<p>Charitable Contributions</p> <p>The Region may make donations or contributions to other not for profit organizations for purposes that, in its opinion after approval by the Board, would directly and indirectly benefit AYSO, the Region, its players, volunteers or the community it services.</p>
