Scholarship Guidelines

Scholarships are available to any registrant on a financial need basis. Scholarship requests should be made in writing by the legal guardian of the registrant, by completing and submitting the Scholarship Application. A copy of this application is available on the regional website www.ayso1103.org.

Scholarship applications should be completed in full, including signature, and submitted via mail to AYSO Region 1103, PO Box 102, Amana, IA 52203, or via email to registrar@ayso1103.org. Proof of income may be required, but should not be provided unless specifically requested. Scholarship applications and awards are considered confidential information and should not be shared with other players, parents, or volunteers.

To apply for a scholarship, please first register your child to participate with Region 1103 for the upcoming season. Go to the regional website www.ayso1103.org, and click on the “Register Here” link in the right hand margin. Complete the player registration process up to but not including the Online Payment option. Once you have registered, please complete and submit a scholarship form. Include a printed copy of the player registration form. You may print this form by choosing “Print Player Form” from the main eAYSO screen. If you are unable to print a player form in this fashion, then you have not yet completed the registration process and should choose Update Player Information to complete this process.

Upon notification of scholarship, you will have 30 days, or until the late registration deadline, whichever is greater, to accept the scholarship or acknowledge the refusal, by replying to the notification email, and submitting any full or partial payment that is required. Please note that in the event of a partial scholarship being awarded, players will not be assigned to teams until remaining partial fee is submitted. If the late registration deadline passes during a scholarship application process, the player will have a minimum of 30 days to submit partial (or full payment, if scholarship is denied) before the late fee is assessed. Scholarship applications received after the registration deadline will still be considered, but the late registration fee may or may not be included in any partial or full scholarships awarded. Uniform cost is generally NOT included in a scholarship offer.

Scholarship funding is limited, and as such the board may limit either the number of scholarships awarded, or the amount of those scholarships. As scholarships are totally need based, each will be considered in it's own right, on a case by case basis. Scholarships are awarded on a season by season basis. It is not a given that if you received a scholarship in the past, you will receive one in the future.

While AYSO is a volunteer organization, and everyone is strongly encouraged to volunteer in any capacity they are able, a scholarship will not under any circumstance be tied to a player or parent's ability or willingness to volunteer.
