AYSO 2019 EAGLE CLASSIC TOURNAMENT

Team Invitation



AYSO Region 23 The Heights cordially extends an invitation to all Boys and Girls teams in divisions U10 through U14 to participate in the **2019 Eagle Classic**.

- Scope:** AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.
- When:** U10 – U14 B/G – Saturday & Sunday, April 27 – April 28, 2019 (We play rain or shine)
- Where:** The tournament will be held at:
Schabarum Regional Park Soccer Complex, 17250 E. Colima Road, Rowland Heights, CA 91748
(Use Albatross entrance)
Newton Middle School, 15616 Newton St, Hacienda Heights, CA 91745
No pets are allowed at fields.
- Who:** AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered and have played in the AYSO 2018 primary season. Eligibility based on age as of **July 31, 2018**. Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per team). No Co-ed Teams. AYSO laminated ID cards required
- What:** Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed minimum 3 games in pool play. The top teams, based on Rules of Competition, will advance to the medal round on Sunday afternoon. All pool play games will be as follows: 50 min for U14 & U12; 40 min for U10
- Why:** The purpose of the Eagle Classic Tournament is to provide the players, parents and coaches of teams interested a safe, fair, and fun venue to continue their soccer experience during the spring. Revenues from the Eagle Classic Tournament will be implemented to provide equipment and other resources to the players and coaches of Region 23's spring season.
- Awards:** All players and head coach per team will receive an Eagle Classic Tournament pin. Championship Coaches will receive our ever-popular crystal trophy. All semi-finalists and finalists will receive awards (medals).
- Entry Fee, Refunds:** \$500 for U-12 through U14 & \$450 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, we will only issue a refund if a replacement team can be found, less any cost to register that replacement team.
- Referee Fee, Refunds:** \$225, refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament.
- Rules:** A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.
- Acceptance:** **The application deadline is March 27, 2019 (U10-U14).** Incomplete applications will be returned. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs. of the application deadline(s) or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Accepted teams will be posted on the AYSO 23 Regional website, which will serve as notification of acceptance. Regions will not be permitted to switch or change teams once accepted. All teams not accepted will be notified via email within 48 hours of the respective division application deadline. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.

How: Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Regional check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, along with the Team Application, Team Roster, and Referee Information to the Tournament Registrar address below. Regional commissioner must sign application and team roster. Appropriate referee administrator must sign referee information form. See referee form for details.
