**Minutes**

- Meeting called to order by Vine Rodriguez at 7:06 PM

- Awards – The group agreed to only provide participation awards for U8 and below. U10 and older will get 1<sup>st</sup> and/or 2<sup>nd</sup> place awards based on playoff results
- All-Stars
  - It was reported that the all-star season will be comprised of 2 games each Saturday in January
  - Everyone must play half the game
  - Sweatshirts have been purchased for those who ordered and paid for sweatshirts (\$25 ea.)
  - The 1<sup>st</sup> place team will advance to Section Championship
  - The new uniforms look nice, we need Score to use our new logo from now on
- Age Determination
  - Section 11 has decided to change to Calendar year even though AYSO National has said we will stay with School year.
  - Clubs have reported the change in Age determination makes it less confusing to know your age division. However, players are not happy no longer playing with classmates.
  - Not sure how Blue Sombrero will handle the change
- Costa Mesa Classic
  - Vince reported that the tournament paperwork has been submitted.
  - We are hoping for 50-60 teams
  - We again will use Signup Genius for tracking volunteers
  - Gas Golf carts will be rented for the tournament
  - We need to make sure someone bring extra water for the portable bathroom sinks
- Extra program teams need to declare which players are need to replace those who are not returning for spring. We don't want to move players to extra after the spring teams have been formed.
- Expo
  - Those confirmed to attend include: Lisa, George, Fernando, Kellie, Margaret, Anne McEligot
  - Lance and Amanda may possibly attend
  - The team parent meeting needs to be changed from 2/28 to 3/2
- Lance provided an update on the progress of transition to the new website (Blue Sombrero)
- Equipment and other Purchases
  - Vince reported that the following items have been purchased/ordered
    - Wheel for the permanent goals at TeWinkle
    - Captain Bands for the all-star teams
    - Stakes for the goals and nets
    - Bungies for the nets

- Player ratings
  - We received player ratings from a few coaches. We will enter those scores and the All-star tryout scores to help with team balancing.
  - Next fall we need to have coaches meeting where the ratings are turned in to be eligible for playoffs.
- Changes in small sided games next year
  - U8 will play 4v4 with no goal keeper, if we can get enough players we may want to have U7 play 4v4 and U8 5v5
  - U10 will use a build out line
  - U6 will remain 3v3
- The farm will be open for use beginning February 8, 2017
- After the Pilot Cup, JHSC #1 and #2 are schedule for adding artificial turf
