

Volunteering at the Snack Shack

*Downey AYSO Region 24 is an **ALL VOLUNTEER** organization. From the coach, team manager, treasurer to the commissioner, they all volunteer their time to make this soccer season possible for everyone. **NONE OF THE VOLUNTEERS GET PAID.** This organization needs volunteers to have a successful soccer year and for all to enjoy.*

*In order to make every year a success, parents and/or guardians volunteer for each registered player. A parent/ guardian (over the age of 16) volunteer 3 continuous hours on a specific date and time assigned to each child's team. There are two places that teams are assigned to volunteer; parking or snack shack. Parking /Snack Shack dates/times are just assigned so they do not interfere with **that team's game** time. **The coach DOES NOT** choose the date/time of the assigned volunteer duty. The Volunteer Coordinator/Commissioner does not know if you have other children or if they are playing at the same time you are assigned to volunteer. The Coordinator does the best to make sure it is not during **THE ASSIGNED TEAM'S** game.*

*Please note: **ONLY** the Volunteer Coordinator, Snack Shack Coordinator or the Commissioner can alter the assigned time/location for a team (**NO ONE ELSE**). If the schedule/ time is changed by anyone else, the team's volunteers credit will be jeopardized. **Please find a 16 or older adult that can cover your assigned time.***

- The Head Coach is the only **one EXEMPT from Volunteer Duty** (It doesn't matter if you referee) **for that team that is assigned.**
- If the Head Coach has two children (**he/she is the head coach for BOTH teams**) he/she **does not have to complete** volunteer duty.
- If the Head Coach has 2 children on **the same team**, he/she **will have to work 3 hours** for one of the children.
- If the Head Coach has 2 children (he/she is **only the head coach for one team**) he/she **has to complete 3 hours** of volunteering.

Snack Shack:

*-Sign-in at snack shack. Sign out **ONLY** after your shift is complete.*

-Sign in sheet with be done specifically for each team. Please make sure you are signing in on the right one or you will not get credit.

*-Snack shack food is for purchase **ONLY**.*

*-16 years or older can volunteer (**NO** children inside the snack shack due to safety concerns).*

-Gloves must be used when handling food that is not individually wrapped.

-Food cost will be posted on a board and sometimes on the individual boxes.

-No sitting or talking on the phone while volunteering at the snack shack. This is for your safety.

-First shift (6:30 am); help with set-up, prepping food, cooking, etc. If the snack shack is too crowded with volunteers, you will be asked to help elsewhere.

-IF your shift is scheduled last (11:00-2:00 pm), you will be asked to help pick up trash around the school, help tear down snack shack, tear down nets, etc.

*-**ALL DAY** volunteers will present ticket for food.*

-Referees will present ticket for food.

-3 continuous hours (not 1 hour today, 2 next week, etc.)

-3 continuous hours per registered child (3 hours – 1 registered player, 6 hours – 2 registered players, 9 hours – 3 registered players, and so on).

-Referees are not exempt from volunteering for their child.

*-**ONLY** person **EXCLUDED** from volunteering for snack shack duty is **the head coach for that day/time**.*

Volunteering in the Parking Lot

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*Please note: **ONLY** the Volunteer Coordinator, Snack Shack Coordinator or the Commissioner can alter the assigned time/location for a team (**NO ONE ELSE**). If the schedule/ time is changed by anyone else, the team's volunteers credit will be jeopardized. **Please find a 16 or older adult that can cover your assigned time.***

- The Head Coach is the only **one EXEMPT from Volunteer Duty** (It doesn't matter if you referee) **for that team that is assigned.**
- If the Head Coach has two children (**he/she is the head coach for BOTH teams**) he/she **does not have to complete** volunteer duty.
- If the Head Coach has 2 children on **the same team**, he/she **will have to work 3 hours** for one of the children.
- If the Head Coach has 2 children (he/she is **only the head coach for one team**) he/she **has to complete 3 hours** of volunteering.

Parking:

*-Sign-in at information booth. Sign out **ONLY** after your shift is complete.*

-16 years or older (please no children due to safety concerns).

-Highly suggest: wear comfortable shoes and clothes, hat and/or sunglasses, sunscreen, and a safety vest.

-No sitting on chairs, using laptops, talking on the phone is permitted. This keeps the focus away from monitoring moving vehicles and everyone's safety.

-3 continuous hours (not one hour today, 2 next week, etc.)

-First shift (7:00 am); help with set-up of parking, nets, etc. If the parking is too crowded with volunteers, you will be asked to help elsewhere.

-IF your shift is scheduled last (11:30-2:30 pm), you will be asked to help pick up trash around the school, help tear down info/ referee booths, tear down nets, etc.

-3 continuous hours per registered child (3 hours – 1 registered player, 6 hours – 2 registered players, 9 hours – 3 registered players, and so on).

-Referees are not exempt from volunteering for their child.

*-**ONLY** person **EXCLUDED** from volunteering for parking duty is **the head coach for that team**.*
