



COACH OATH OF COMMITMENT

The North Atlanta Football League requires the following guidelines. They are to be followed and adhered to by all coaches.

- By the signing of this document, coaches and their spouses are agreeing that they are able to manage their vocational and family commitments in such a way that coaches will be present at a minimum of 75% of all practices and games. Leadership cannot be absent - it must be present to be effective.
 - Failure to comply and fulfill this important time commitment will result in suspension and/ or the loss of coaching privileges.
- All coaches must be consistent when attending scheduled practices and games.
 - If you are unable to attend a scheduled practice or game, communicate and delegate these responsibilities to your assistant coaches.
- Coaches must agree to adhere to the system set by the NAFL for operating their teams.
- Do not use the position of head coach to promote your own welfare, but use the position to protect the welfare of the children.
- Respect should be given to the players, adults, and those in position of authority.
 - Any profanity, disrespectful or degrading remarks or actions shown towards players, referees; league officials, and/or spectators will not be tolerated. This applies to practices, games and/or any time you are in any of the parks.
- No physical violence or abuse may be shown toward the children, referees, league officials, other coaches, parents, and/or spectators.
 - This rule also applies to your own family members.
- Use of alcohol or tobacco products will not be tolerated at the facilities at any time prior to, during, or after your team practices or games.
- Violations of any local league rules, and/or the official playing rules for any reason will be met with a warning, suspension, or termination of your coaching responsibilities.
- Coaches of the NAFL may not take players from our teams to create another team in a different
- Coaches may not deviate from these guidelines or any league rules at any time.
- Scouting or filming of another teams practice or scrimmage is strictly prohibited.

Any coach who does not adhere to these guidelines may be given a warning, suspended, or terminated from your coaching responsibilities based upon the decision of the NAFL President, Athletic Director and / or Board of Directors.

These guidelines may be amended or superseded by action of the North Atlanta Football League (NAFL). Any additions or revisions by the NAFL will be forwarded to all coaches at the appropriate time.

SAFEKIDS PROGRAM

The following is the policy of North Atlanta Football League. Full compliance is required of all Board Members, Head Coaches, and Assistant Coaches.

- I am committed to provide a safe environment and to prevent child abuse and sexual misconduct.
- I will make every reasonable effort to ensure that every person involved in my team will abide by the SafeKids guidelines.
- I will take appropriate action on all allegations of child abuse and/or sexual misconduct. All allegations will be reported immediately to the authorities for investigation and will cooperate fully with any such investigation.
- I will comply with the following list of preventive measures as they pertain to participants of NAFL:
 - Physical, mental, and verbal abuses are forbidden
 - Inappropriate touching is forbidden
 - I will not ride solo in a vehicle or be alone with a child other than my own.
 - If a child needs special attention (one-on-one), I will do so with the assistance of the parent, if possible or, at the very least, another adult.
