11-12 Division Overview

Both leagues are design to provide optimal base recreational experience. The focus is improving fundamental playing and team building skills, as well as sportsmanship. Majors and Minors division planned but will depend on then number of available players and subsequent teams. 12 teams are preferred to have 2 divisions. Minor is geared toward developing players and Major is geared toward returning players 11/12 or new players that have played other sports and have an understanding of the fundamentals of baseball. League age is determined based upon child's age on April 30, 2018.

Practice & Game Information
