13-15 DIVISION OVERVIEW

The goal of the division is to provide the optimal recreational experience. The focus is improving fundamental playing, team building skills and sportsmanship. League age is determined based upon the player's age on April 30, 2018. **ALL 13-15 Division players will need to attend player skill evaluations as attendance is mandatory for every player.** Evaluations will be held in advance of both the spring and fall seasons and all teams will be re-drafted. We will have three (3) one-hour evaluation slots. Time slots will be assigned and emailed to parents/players. The FBC evaluation/draft process is designed to provide a level skill level among the teams within the league at the start of the season.

PRACTICE & GAME INFORMATION

The 13-15 teams practice and play games twice a week. Practices may be scheduled any day of the week (including Sunday). The division will be scheduled to play 14 regular season games plus an All-star game in the middle of the season. At the conclusion of the regular season, there will a league tournament played. Parents will be contacted by their coach after teams are assigned at the coaches' meeting/draft.

EQUIPMENT

PLAYERS are to provide glove, cleats (metal or plastic), helmet and regulation bat. Franklin Baseball Club provides the team uniform: baseball cap, team jersey, pants and belt. Each team will also be provided a set of catcher's gear, but catchers may use their own as well.

BATS: Bats may not exceed 34" in length and the barrel may not exceed 2⁵/₈" in diameter. All aluminum/alloy barrel bats are allowed. Composite barrel bats must be certified and marked BBCOR.50. Wood barrel bats conforming to the specifications of Official Baseball Rule 1.10 are allowed.
