9-10 Division Overview

All returning Majors and Minors players will have to participate in either Majors tryouts or Minors evaluations designed to promote parity amongst all of the teams. The Minors division is geared toward developing players and Majors is a more competitive brand of recreational baseball. Both the Majors and Minors division players are selected by a coach draft and 'player or coach requests' are not accepted. League age is determined based upon child's age on April 30, 2018.

Practice & Game Information

9/10 teams practice and play games twice a week. Practices will be scheduled any day of the week (including Sunday).
9/10 team games are 1 hour 30 minutes in length during the week and 1 hour 45 minutes on Saturday.
Both divisions will also play a tournament playoff at the conclusion of the season. The tournament will conclude in early June after the Memorial Day holiday.
Parents will be contacted by their child's coach after teams are assigned at the coaches meeting, which will take place on Feb 11 for majors and Feb 18 for minors.
