Parents Code of Conduct

1. Remember, children are involved in organized sports for their enjoyment, not yours. Recognize the positive things that your child accomplishes in each game. Do not be critical.

3. Maintain a positive sideline demeanor by not berating coaches, referees, players or other parents.
4. CHEER POSITIVELY! Your child's teammates and opponents are young amateurs, not professionals. Cheer for good play on the part of all players.
5. NO COACHING FROM THE SIDE LINES! Support the coach and allow the coach to coach no matter how much you disagree with him/her.
6. RESPECT THE REFEREE! THEIR DECISIONS ARE FINAL! Improper behavior can result in yellow or red card and /or forfeit of the game.
7. No foul or abusive language will be tolerated.
8. No alcohol is allowed at any time. Showing up to a practice or game while intoxicated could result in disciplinary action.
