



## **SOUTH CHEROKEE Parent Code of Conduct**

- 1) I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other youth sporting event.
- 2) I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
- 3) I will remember that the game is for the players and not for the adults, that winning should never be placed ahead of the emotional and physical well-being of any child.
- 4) I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning and will never yell at or ridicule any child for making a mistake.
- 5) I will support coaches and officials working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all and will never question, discuss or confront coaches during the game or in front of my child or the other players.
- 6) I will support a sports environment that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth events.
- 7) I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- 8) I will help my child enjoy youth sports by doing whatever I can to help the team have a positive, pleasurable and memorable experience.
- 9) I will respect the property of others including the South Cherokee facilities and will teach my child to do the same.
- 10) I understand that if I act in an unsportsmanlike manner or in any way that is detrimental to the league, a player, official, coach, volunteer, recreation personnel, or another spectator, I will be asked to leave and may be subject to further disciplinary action. I further agree to comply with any appropriate park actions and decisions regarding such behavior, and I do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and agree to hold harmless the local league, chartering organization, board members, and the coaches for any claim arising out of disciplinary action or other decision by the SC Baseball Board of Directors.
