



Southern Soccer Academy Club Dues

Southern Soccer Academy (SSA) dues should be made in full or installments. Payment(s) can be made by cash, credit card or by post-dated checks.

Payment can either be paid in full by cash or check. All credit card payments will need to be made when you register online. Payment plan options will include up to **four** postdated checks or credit card transactions for the under 9 thru under 14 players and or up to **three** post-dated checks, or credit card transactions for under 15 thru under 19 players.

Teams will practice a minimum of twice a week. Optional skill sessions and Goalkeeper training are available to all Academy and Select players.

SSA dues are similar to tuition. Dues are not optional. If your child is unable to attend a tournament or train for any reason including illness or injuries (except as noted below), you will not receive a refund. No adjustment or reduction in Club Dues is allowed. Players, who suffer serious injuries lasting more than three months, however may submit a request to SSA Board for release of payment of Dues for that period.

Allocation of Dues to Services Provided by Southern Soccer Academy

Items paid for by your dues include: Coaching, team training, skills training, pre season camp, referee cost/assignments, coaching education, GSSA League Fees, Club administration expenses.

Payment Options/Schedule

The SSA's Academy and Select Payment schedule will be distributed after tryouts with registration information. Payment can either be paid in full by cash or check. All credit card payments will need to be made when you register online. Payment plan options will include up to **FOUR** postdated checks or credit card transactions for the under 9 thru under 14 players and or **THREE** post-dated checks or credit card transactions for under 15 thru under 19/20 players.

Financial Aid

SSA has developed a program that provides financial aid to qualifying youth athletes in order to play soccer. This program maintains confidentiality while assisting players with registration fees and some coaching fees. It does not cover the cost of uniforms, travel expenses and tournament fees. Request for financial aid will be based on a first come, first served basis and available funds are limited each year. **Families receiving financial aid are required to volunteer additional hours to SSA.** Any family member of the player may work these volunteer hours and will be credited toward reducing the amount of financial aid. Financial Aid applications can be downloaded from our club web site or requested from the club office by emailing Admin@ssaelite.com . Forms should be submitted to Admin@ssaelite.com or mailed to the club office ASAP.

Payment Default

The SSA is a membership organization. Unpaid dues represent funds not available to meet Club expenses. Any player delinquent in dues by 7 days or more will be notified by the Club, and suspended from participating in any Club/team activity. **A late fee or a returned check fee of \$35 will also be added to the installments.**

Team Expenses

The Club dues do not cover team expenses, which include but are not limited to, tournament entry fees, practice t-shirts, uniforms, referee fees for friendly games, optional camp fees and coach's lodging expense for out of town tournaments (i.e. 100+ miles one way). Teams will collect fees according to their team financial policy. Academy Players must update their availability on the team Shutter-Fly account by the deadline set by the Academy Director, otherwise they are subject to a late payment fee of \$25.

Release Policy

If a player quits or wishes to be released from the Club, all fees to the SSA will need to be paid in full as per GYSA Rule 310.2d by credit card, money order or cash.

(310.2d Once a select program player is rostered to a team, that player's financial obligation as published by the club and accepted by the player must be satisfied before a transfer will be approved.)

Additional Information

1. Club policy is to allow coaches to train more than one of the club's teams. Therefore it is inevitable that team coaches will occasionally be unable to attend certain games. Every effort will be made by the Club to arrange for a suitable alternative staff member to coach the team on game day.
2. Select soccer is a competitive environment. Efforts are made to attract good soccer players during tryouts **and** throughout the year. Rosters can and will change.
3. SSA is able to operate successfully at a lower cost due to the involvement of parent volunteers. Each family is expected to volunteer 4 hours of their time to help SSA in its events, day to day running and tournaments.

The above are part of SSA's policies and do not affect a family's commitment to pay the Club dues in the appropriate timely manner.
