

# Port Huron Figure Skating Club 2020-2021 Season

## Welcome Back Everyone!

The Port Huron Figure Skating Club has made some changes not only with COVID-19 health policies but, also in the way we run our skating seasons. We are now combining our Fall, Winter & Spring seasons all together to give you a more consistent schedule. Our program offers ice time to skaters of all ages and levels from Oct. 3, 2020 to May 27, 2021.

The **COVID Ice Policies** have been established and approved by the PHFSC Board of Directors. A temperature will be taken of everyone entering the rink and **at this time a MASK covering your nose and mouth MUST be worn by everyone at ALL times.**

**Payments/Policies:** Payments will be due on the 10<sup>th</sup> of every month. If you will be paying with PayPal, Visa/MasterCard – a 3.5% fee will be added to the cost when using these forms of payment. No Refunds and all sessions are subject to change.

**Fundraising:** The PHFSC relies on the participation of our members in all fundraising efforts. Some fundraisers will be split to give back to the skater which in return gives them “skater credits” this will allow a skater to purchase only ice time.

**Calendar/Make Up’s** – the calendar of dates on the registration form is set up so you can see what days are canceled from the beginning of the season in October to the end of the season in May. We are allowing a skater to “Make Up” one day for every session they sign up for because we understand that a skater may be sick or has a school event on the same day they skate. A “pass” for their session will be allowed to be made up on another day, please talk to your private coach so they can let the appropriate person know before the skater makes up their session.

**SafeSport** – Coaches, Board Members and Parent Volunteers must be SafeSport trained and certified. All coaches must be members of the Port Huron Figure Skating Club and be CER certified to be on club ice.

**Ice Session descriptions:** **Sr Open** ice is for skaters at the Pre Preliminary FS level or higher. **Jr Open** ice is for skaters with No test level up to Pre Preliminary MIF, **Open** ice will be a general session.

**Learn To Figure Skate (LTFS)**- This is a 50 min session for skaters who are working on Basic 4, 5 and 6 badge with 30 min of group instruction and 20 minutes of practice time on their own. We will introduce the 3 disciplines of figure skating (freestyle, Moves in the Field and Dance) all in one class.

**Power Skating Classes** – We offer 3 levels of Power Skating to the hockey skaters in our area. This will create more powerful players in the future. Pwr Sk8 1 is an Intro to Power Skating. They must be able to skate forwards, backwards, turn and stop. Pwr Sk8 2 will be for the U8 skaters, and Pwr Sk8 3 is for our advanced Pee Wee and Squirt players. Levels will be approved by the Power Skating Coordinator.
