Parents - Spectators - Volunteers

We will support the players, coaches, umpires & league officials.
We will not coach or officiate from the stands.
We will be positive role models.
We will display & instill in all players the principals of good sportsmanship & team play.
We will conduct ourselves in a manner that best serves the interests of the players.
We will do our best to provide the players a positive experience.
We will make certain that our children show respect for all other players, coaches, umpires, officials and spectators.
We agree not to ridicule or demean players, coaches or umpires in any public forum.
We agree to inform the coach of any disability or ailment that may affect the safety of our child.
We will comply with all the decisions of officials.
We will support the rules, regulations and bylaws as established or endorsed by the GAA.
We will not question an umpires call.
We will respect the opponent and avoid any confrontation with opposing players, spectators or coaches
We will be drug and alcohol free while at any GAA Athletic event where there are children present.

Players

Players will:

Display good sportsmanship and team play at all times
Follow the direction of the coaching staff
Respect all coaches, players, league officials, umpires and spectators
Make every attempt to be on time and be ready to play for all games and practices

Players will not:

Use abusive or profane language
Taunt or humiliate any other player
Question an umpires call
Abuse, mistreat or mishandle any GAA equipment or property

Consequences

All members of the GAA are subject to consequences which may lead to discipline or possible termination of membership as determined necessary by the GAA board due to failure to comply with the code of conduct. All members agree to abide by these rules as part of their registration in the program. It is the responsibility of all members to be familiar with the guidelines set forth in the code of conduct and for parents to explain & enforce this code of conduct with their own children.
