



## Parent's Code of Conduct

I hereby pledge to provide support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in softball by this code of conduct.

I will encourage fair play (good sportsmanship) and respect by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, and softball event.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.

I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will provide support for the coaches and official working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.

I will refrain from coaching my child and other players from the sidelines, thereby respecting the responsibilities I have placed on the coach.

I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco free sports environment for my child and agree by refraining from their use at all softball events.

I will refrain from verbal abuse, unsportsmanlike and disruptive use of noisemakers, intimidation or physical altercations at any softball venue.

I will remember that the game is for the children and NOT for the adults.

I will refrain from bringing pets to any softball event.

I will do my best to make softball fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and official will respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

I will promise to help my child enjoy the softball experience within my personal constraints, by assisting with coaching, being a respectful fan, providing transportation or whatever I am capable of doing.

I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibility of being a softball coach and that the coach agrees and adheres to the Code of Ethics.

I will obey and support both the letter and the spirit of the laws of the game.

I will use only positive encouragement to either team from the sidelines.

I will conduct myself with dignity and encourage the same behavior from others. Violation of the Code of Conduct in any manner may result in a hearing and/or be just cause for suspension and/or fine.

I understand that I will not be able to choose my coach.

I understand that teams can be broken up and reassigned each season.
