



2021 Spring Season - COVID rules summary

1. All managers, coaches, umpires and volunteers need a negative COVID test result before play begins
2. All managers, coaches, umpires and players will pass through a check-in station at each field
 - a. Check-in station will have:
 - i. Health questionnaire
 - ii. Contactless thermometer
 - iii. Hand sanitizer
3. All managers, coaches, umpires and volunteers will wear masks
4. Players will wear masks when not actively playing.
 - a. We define “actively playing” as when the player has a glove or bat in their hand
5. Hand sanitizing stations will also be placed at each dugout
6. Spectators are required to wear masks and remain socially distant
7. Schedules will allow for 30 minutes between practices or games.
 - a. Check-in to start 10 minutes before session
 - b. Please schedule your arrival and drop off accordingly
8. Each team needs a COVID Safety Volunteer. If you cannot find one, a coach can serve in this role.
 - a. Duties
 - i. Assist with the check-in process
 - ii. Disinfect shared equipment and other high touch items
 - iii. Encourage social distancing
9. No postgame handshakes, hap tips instead
10. Postgame snacks to be handed out by COVID Safety Volunteer
 - a. Hand sanitize prior to handing out items
 - b. Snacks and drinks must be factory sealed items (no home baked goods)
 - c. No free-for-all, with players reaching into open coolers or boxes
