

ALIGNING PORTABLE PITCHING MOUND WHITE FIELD

Note: The portable pitching mound is heavy (approx. 325lbs) a minimum of three volunteers is needed to move the mound. The heaviest part of the mound is the back. Suggest two volunteers in the back and one in the front to move.

1. Using the long metal spikes, run a string line from the middle of second base through the back apex of home plate.
2. Measure (60 feet, 6 inches) from the back point of home plate to the front of the pitching rubber along the string line. Center the rubber along the string at this point.
 - a. 50/70 play: perform procedure in Step 2 to (50 feet)
3. It may be necessary to rake and move dirt around to stabilize the mound.
4. Rake dirt around and on top of the front lip of the portable pitching mound to reduce bad hops.
5. Cover mound with tarp after play.
