



## **Grafton Little League Responsible Spectator Plan**

Grafton Little League (GLL), in coordination with Little League International, wishes to promote the health of all players, coaches, umpires, volunteers and spectators. With this plan we are addressing expectations and guidelines for spectators of our games this summer. The following guidelines will be used to accomplish this goal:

1. All families are encouraged to limit the number of family members and friends they bring to games. Best practice is to keep it to immediate family members. We will target a per-game attendance total of 50 (players, coaches, umps, and fans) until further notice.
2. Anyone who is sick or showing symptoms of being sick should stay home.
3. Family members with weakened or compromised immune systems should stay home to avoid any unnecessary risks. If those with compromised immune systems or conditions do attend, they should consider wearing masks or other protective equipment.
4. Bleachers will be prohibited for spectator seating until further notice and will be re-purposed for players to ensure appropriate social distancing in dugouts. Spectators are encouraged to bring lawn chairs from home.
5. Families should sit together but maintain social distancing from other families. Seating can happen in the grassy areas around the fences on either side of the field or beyond the outfield fences.
6. Social distancing will be required. Each family will be responsible for making sure those with them are being responsible spectators and respecting the space of others.
7. Spectators will not be allowed to chew/spit seeds or other similar items while at complex. Parents are encouraged to leave those items at home.
