Coaches Code of Conduct

- Respect one another
- Respect Official's Decision
- Engage in fair play and abide by all game rules
- Refrain from taunting of officials, coaches, parents, players, spectators or other participants by means of baiting or ridiculing
- Refrain from verbal and/or profane abuse of officials, coaches, parents, players, spectators or other participants
- Refrain from threatening physical violence or engaging in any form of physical violence
- Win or lose with good sportsmanship and strive to make youth sports rewarding for all participants
- No alcohol or tobacco use is allowed in any parking lot, field, or common areas within the Stamford American Little League grounds
- No swinging bats or throwing balls outside of the designated playing areas
- Only a player on the field and at bat may swing a bat
- Observe all signs and all players and spectators should be alert at all times for foul balls and errant throw
- During the game players must remain in the dugout area in an orderly fashion at all times
- After each game, each team must clean up trash in their respective dugout
- All gates shall remain closed after players have entered the field of play
- No children under the age of 16 are to be permitted inside the snack bar

Stamford American Little League may ban the presence at events of any official, coach, parent, player, spectator or other participant who:

1. Engages in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any official, coach, parent, player, spectator or other participant;
2. initiates a fight or scuffle with any official, coach, parent, player, spectator or other participant;
3. engages in repeated or egregious violations of the Code of Conduct, if the conduct occurs at or in connection with such youth sports events.
