Player Safety Plan

Incident reports-Coaching for success form

1. Assess the area; assess to make sure the child is ok.
2. Contact Parent/Guardian if you cannot contact a parent/guardian call the emergency contact.
3. Determine the plan of action with the parent until the parent/guardian is able to arrive to the school.
4. A coach or an adult must stay with the child until a parent/guardian arrives.
5. Coaches must have an incident report form filled out and signed by both the Coach and Parent/Guardian
6. Coaches will hand in the incident form to the Volleyball Advisor and the Advisor will then turn it into the Board
