Understandings of accepting a scholarship:

1 - The recipient and parent/guardian will abide by all rules and regulations and will always display appropriate behavior, act in a courteous and respectable manner while participating in league sponsored activities.

2 - Approved recipients can receive up to a 50% scholarship toward program fees.

3 - Sponsorship forms are also available. This form will allow an employer or local business to sponsor your player

either partially for full sponsorship. We are a 5013c corp., so all donations and scholarships are 100% tax deductible.

Scholarship Guidelines/Eligibility:

The scholarship program is available to anyone desiring financial assistance and who demonstrates financial need as follows:

✓ Applicant must meet the Florida Income Eligibility Guidelines for the free or reduced-price meal program. A letter from school confirming participation must be provided.

✓ In the absence of a school letter or EBT card, the applicant must provide proof of family income.

✓ All supporting documents must accompany the application for the request to be considered.

✓ Requests are limited and are handled on a first-come, first-served basis.

✓ Scholarship requests need to be pre-approved
